Key Takeaways: The Borough President's office has 8 million dollars for capital funding for schools citywide. Deadline for submitting applications is February 20,2023. Individual Schools should open an account (in the Principal's name) on the Borough President's website funding page grant portal. Schools should determine their greatest need and then reach out to The School Construction Authority to get a cost estimate. Its important to know that if the school is in a co-located space, all Principals must sign off on the application.

Mr. Andino shared information about RESO A funding, which is school-specific capital improvement projects that are funded by individual grants from New York City Council members and the Borough President. Funding deadlines for Council members is sometime in March.

Action Items: Follow up with Community School District 5 to make sure that eligible schools in our district apply for funding with the Borough President's office.
