b. Historic Preservation & Landmarks Advocacy Conversation

In a conversation with historic preservation advocates, we reviewed the landmark recommendations listed in the CB10 2012 Historic Preservation report. Here are next steps we identified:

- In collaboration with the Parks Committee, write a letter of recommendation to LPC & Parks about restoring the historic mural inside of the Hansborough facility.
- Conduct outreach to churches to inform them of the benefits of landmark status.
- Participate in Save Harlem Now!'s town hall at City College in the spring.
- Ask CB10 staff or interns to be present at monthly LPC hearings (especially at hearings that address sites in our district).
- Use the SHPO CRIS database as a resource for our research.

- Save Harlem Now is preparing maps of landmarks and historic districts in CB10. Work in collaboration with the group for resource information and advocacy efforts.
- Inquiry re. drafting a letter in support of LPC designation of United Palace Theater in CB12 district. Direct this inquiry to the Board Chair and District Manager.
- Propose plaques or street co-namings to honor and remember demolished historic places in the district.
