# **District Manager's Report Shatic Mitchell**

- Legionnaires Disease
  - 1. 12 to 18 reported cases in the Harlem area
  - 2. It can be contracted by breathing in water
  - 3. If feeling ill go to hospital
  - 4. Initially did not come from Harlem Hospital water towers
- Eric Weigh will be the **CEO of Harlem Hospital**. Ms. Carrington has left for a consulting position.
- In Harlem Hospital the pipes broke on the 15th floor and 75 patients were relocated

- Sign-up for "NOTIFY NYC"; red cross temporary housing
- There will be a Public Hearing on "Open Restaurants Program" by representative Jose Truseo via text amendments.
  - 1. Permanent Open Restaurants Presentations: Successes and Challenges
  - 2. Background Successes, updating and legal changes
  - 3. Vision for Permanent Program: components of sidewalk cafe seating, components of roadway cafe seating, Seasonality only summer months
  - 4. Applications and administration streamlining the process
  - 5. 3 Steps 1) removal of some locations that are prohibited 2) changes to sidewalk ways 3) creation of new spaces for restaurants.
  - **6.** Multiple legal steps will be needed to enact the full permanent program.

  - **8.** Within CB10 ACP Blvd, FD Blvd and Malcolm X Blvd are restricted by residential areas
