- **Civic Education and Training (Local Law 197 of 2025):** Sponsored by Majority Leader Amanda Farías, this law expands civic education by requiring new training for community board members on the Council’s legislative process and parliamentary rules, effective in 2026.
- **Office of Community Board Support (Int. 1314-2025 & Int. 1316-2025):** Proposed bills to establish a dedicated office to provide boards with legal, IT, and community planning support, as well as help in finding accessible meeting spaces.
- **Appointment Power Reform (Int. 1398-2025):** A bipartisan bill introduced in September 2025 by Council Member Frank Morano seeks to amend the City Charter to allow Council Members to directly appoint up to half of their local community board's members, a power currently held by borough presidents.
- **Bylaw Transparency (Local Law 182 of 2025):** This law, sponsored by Council Member David Carr, requires all community boards to publish their bylaws online in a searchable format and update them within two weeks of any changes.
