A DJ from WBLS will be playing the music on the float and will shout out CB 10 and acknowledge the participation and contribution of students from Thurgood Marshall throughout the night. The singer for the float is still TBD. Eboni will pick up supplies, banner, etc. from the CB 10 office before heading over to the float for set up. Chair Harrell reached out and secured a photographer to shoot pictures of the float and participants during the event.
