## Welcome/Introduction

#### **Presentation Item:**

Erich McMillan-McCall, CEO and President, Project 1 Voice, INC

• Erich McMillan of Project 1 Voice presented to promote and support the Black Theatre. They have been established for five years with over 30 productions across the country. The play in marking the 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary is called "Home". It also marks the 150th year anniversary of the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution. The play will be held at the Brooklyn Heritage Center on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and in New York at the Harlem Hospital Pavilion. The tickets range from \$25.00 - \$75.00.

#### **Discussion Item:**

- Kevin Bitterman will look at the DCA distribution of funding in the Harlem area. Why are we not getting proper funding?

- Possible re-vamping of mission statement to include "more funding for Public Performing Arts Center.
- In looking at the re-phrasing of the statement, we will take a look at the wording of community boards.
