Discussion/Presentations

- New York Harm Educators Angie Woody & Terrell Jones conducted the presentation. New York Harm Reduction Educators have provided services in CB 11 for 25 years and in CB 10 for 10 years.
 - a) The program will expand their services in Central Harlem by providing hygiene kits, showers and related services for clients in their drop-in.
 - b) The program discussed their Safe Syringe Disposal Kiosks that are in parks. They are installed by the NYC Parks Department in parks where many syringes are found, and are locked, tamper-proof containers where you can safely throw away syringes. The kiosks are serviced weekly by a local syringe service program. There are no syringe kiosks in CB10.
 - c) Mr. Jones indicated that he would begin efforts to do outreach in designated parks in CB 10. District Manager will provide New York Harm Educators with the information.
