a. East Harlem Re-Zoning plan

Committee discussed the East Harlem Re-Zoning plan and the affects it may or may not have on CB10.

#### **b.** The Frederick

Committee discussed concerns regarding the reaction from many board members to one of the most affordable, community-oriented ULURP proposals presented to CB10 in several years, despite the Land Use Committee's unanimous resolution to support the project.

#### c. AMI

Discussed the reoccurring concern regarding Federal AMI levels not meeting the needs of many Harlem residents, especially those most affected by systemic socio-economic challenges. CB10 has no immediate oversight of AMI; however, we can advocate for lowering AMI income bands for our district.

#### **d.** Communications to HPD

CB10 Land Use and Housing Committee, in partnership with Dr. Kay Samuels, will draft two memos to HPD: 1) Inquire about the current HPD process for issuing RFP's for HPD projects; 2) Request inclusion of needs specific to Central Harlem to be included in all RFP's issued for HPD projects, addressing needs such as: HPD to discuss site and RFP with CB Chair prior to public notice; Set asides for seniors living; Deeper affordability; Mixture of commercial and residential space—not all restaurants and bars—but also arts & culture venues to retain the cultural character of the village of Harlem. Motion for creation of memos made by C. Powell, seconded by G. Harrell. Unanimous support.
