**Whereas,** Caramba Corp. dba TBA – 1051 Saint Nicholas Ave. (btw 162<sup>nd</sup> & 163<sup>rd</sup>) 10032, has duly notified Community Board 12 Manhattan of its intention to file an application for a new On-Premises Liquor License; and

Whereas, the Licensing Committee met on May 12, 2021 to hear comments from the community and the precinct regarding this establishment's application for a new On-Premises Liquor License; and

Whereas, The proposed restaurant is on the street level of a six (6) story mixed residential and commercial building; and

Whereas, the proposed venue will operate with 6 employees, total of 15 tables, 36 chairs, 13 bar stools, with a total maximum legal capacity of 74 persons. Hours of operation are Thursday through Saturday until 2:00 am and Sunday through Wednesday until 12:00 am and the DJ will only play Thursday through Saturday; and

Whereas, the proposed Method of Operation includes DJ and Live Music, karaoke only and will have one (1) NYS licensed security guard; and

Whereas, the owner will install a sound limiter on all associated equipment, and attest that the space will be sufficiently sound proofed. There will be no third party promoters and the owner will follow all the New York City and State codes and regulations for the establishment operation; and

Whereas, committee members who live in the area express concern for the requested late hours of operation, the level of noise, hookah smoking and too many people hanging out in the street; and

Whereas, the owner agreed in writing to the following stipulations:

- Owner will provide proof of soundproofing installation before CB12M General Meeting on May 21, 2021
- Owner will install sound limiter
- Meet with the 33<sup>rd</sup> Precinct
- Post "No double parking" and "No valet parking sign"
- Owner will post a Good Neighbor sign in a publically visible place in the establishment;

**Whereas**, the applicant did not submit a copy of the receipt of a purchase of a sound limiter by Friday May 21th as requested by the Licensing Committee on one of it's stipulations; therefore be,
