Dear Commissioner Trottenberg :

Please be advised that at the General Meeting Tuesday, February 25, 2014 Community Board 12 Manhattan passed a resolution by a vote of (33) In Favor, (0) Opposed, (0) Abstain, requesting that the Department of Transportation make sure that Muni-meter payment stations in our district are located within sufficient and mandated proximity to one another to maximize the convenience for our parking public.

Whereas, most commercial 125th St. corridor, both in Northern Manhattan, ends at 7 PM, and,

Whereas, the timeframe for metered parking on most commercial streets, such as Dyckman Street, and the establishments on W. 181st St. are closed by 7 PM, and,

Whereas, once metered parking ends, the parking spaces become available for residents, and,

Whereas, on W. 181st St. between St. Nicholas and Broadway the timeframe for meter parking currently ends at 10 PM, therefore,

Be it resolved that community Board 12, Manhattan, requests that the Department of Transportation change the ending time for metered parking on all of W. 181st St. to 7 PM, in conformance with the times on W. 181st St. and other similar streets, and,

Be it further resolved, that Community Board 12, Manhattan, calls upon the Department of Transportation to make sure that Muni-meter payment stations in our district are located within sufficient and mandated proximity to one another to maximize the convenience for our parking public.
