**Whereas**, the Owner claimed that an assault at the location took place outside of the premise and did not involve the bartender, but the 33<sup>rd</sup> Precinct representative confirmed that the incident did indeed involve the bartender and was related to a dispute which began within the premises and that there was a second incident within the premise; and

**Whereas**, based on the facts which came to light and the conflicting testimony of the applicant, the applicant withdrew his application for a Change in Method of Operation knowing that if said application proceeded to a vote, it would have been rejected by the Committee; now, therefore, be it

**Resolved,** that Community Board 12, Manhattan, accepts the recommendation of the licensing committee and **Objects** to the New York State Liquor Authority new on-premises liquor license application for WE=ESK Inc. dba Fireball.
