Dear Honorable Senators and Congressman:

The following resolution was passed by Community Board #12 at its general meeting on April 24, 2001:

WHEREAS nursing homes are a vital component of the health care system to provide competent, compassionate and appropriate care of the elderly; and

WHEREAS strong enforcement of government regulation has proven to be an important part of maintaining the quality of services in nursing homes in this community and nationwide; and

WHEREAS nursing homes receive significant funding through the Federal Medicare program; and

WHEREAS the United States Congress is considering the Medicare Education and Regulatory Fairness Act (S-452 in the Senate and HR-868 in the House); and

WHEREAS this legislation would give nursing homes the opportunity to

- delay corrections of substandard care and of serious violations:
- delay payment of fines for penalties for actions taken against them;
- mount blanket challenges to Federal regulations they don't like;

and would keep the Federal government from closing facilities with a history of serious violations, pending a lengthy appeals process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Community Board 12, Manhattan opposes the Medicare Education and Regulatory Fairness Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Community Board 12, Manhattan urges Senators Hillary Clinton and Charles Schumer to vote against S-452; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Community Board 12, Manhattan urges Congressman Charles Rangel to vote against HR-868.
