Please be advised that Community Board 12-Manhattan, at its General Meeting on April 22, 2008, overwhelmingly passed the following resolution in opposition to ULURP Application 070221ZMM by a vote of 32-2-3-0:

Whereas:

W&S Broadway Group LLC submitted ULURP Application No. 070221ZMM to the NYC Department of City Planning seeking to establish a C1-4 commercial overlay district within an existing R7-2 district; and

Whereas:

The proposed rezoning would extend an existing C1-4 commercial overlay by 200 feet along Broadway and affect two contiguous five-story residential buildings, 4640 and 4646 Broadway, which contain a total of 72 units and two existing non-conforming ground-floor retail uses (retail uses that pre-date the current R7-2 zoning); and

Whereas:

The buildings are approximately 100 years old and were acquired by the applicant in November 2005; and

Whereas:

The proposed rezoning would permit six ground-floor residential units to be legally converted to retail uses, allowing the buildings' floor area devoted to retail uses to increase from 1,400 square feet to 5,200 square feet; and

Whereas:

The six affected units are rent-stabilized (two of the units are currently vacant), and the tenants are entitled to lease renewals as long as they wish to reside there. W&S intends to convert the ground-floor units to retail uses after convincing the tenants to relocate to other apartments in these buildings or in other buildings it owns in the neighborhood; and

Whereas:

A large contingent of tenants from the two buildings attended the public hearing held by the Land Use Committee on April 2, 2008 to consider the ULURP application, and they voted unanimously against the proposed rezoning; and

Whereas:

Community Board 12 has identified the lack of affordable housing as the #1 problem in Washington Heights-Inwood, ranking both the preservation and creation of affordable housing as long-time budget priorities, and this board has strongly opposed previous attempts by landlords to remove desperately needed apartments from our housing stock in order to replace them with retail and other uses; now, therefore be it

Resolved:

Community Board 12-Manhattan strongly opposes ULURP Application No. 070221ZMM submitted by W&S Broadway Property Group, LLC seeking to extend an existing C1-4 commercial overlay district within an existing R7-2 district.
