The recommendation is exclusively for the method of operation presented on February 2^{nd} , 2010 and if the method of operation changes the owner must submit beforehand a new method of operation form to CB12 and the SLA.

The Economic Development Committee having met on February 2nd, 2010 to hear comments from the community, and 33rd Precinct would have objected had this been a renewal license and due to the fact that there are new owners, they are withholding opinion until they can get in contact with the new owners; therefore be it

Community Board 12 (Manhattan) **recommends** the State Liquor Authority **NOT grant** a **new On Premise Liquor License** for Las Reynas Restaurant Inc. (Amistad) due to protocol that new applicants must appear before the Community Board to present their method of operation.
