The following resolution was passed by Community Board #12, Manhattan at its General Meeting on September 26, 2000:

Whereas:

On 9 September 2000 Community Board 12, Manhattan held a Public Hearing in the matter of a Department of City Planning application for a zoning text amendment (N 010065 ZRY) which would modify the city's sign regulations, and

Whereas:

The proposed regulations would 1) extend the C8 District sign regulations, including all size, illumination, projection and height provisions to all manufacturing districts, 2) limit the size of accessory signs within 200 feet of a park or arterial highway; 3) limit the size of flashing signs on waterfront blocks and prohibit them on all piers and platforms; 4) allow the modification of sign regulations for general large scale developments by Special Permit; 5) prohibit the replacement of non-conforming painted wall and flexible fabric signs that do not have supporting structures; and 6) allow the Commissioner of Buildings to establish sign illumination standards, allowing non-conforming signs to comply within one year, therefore
