

**CB12 Traffic and Transportation Committee Meeting

- 1. Call to order 7:05 pm**
- 2. Update from DOT, Lyle Blackwood** included discussion of dangerous conditions on Riverside Drive bridge work at construction diversions, particularly left turn at W. 160th St. Ashley Bogosian raised the issues. Connected to Valerie Torchon. DOT has been trying to address the spot given # of accidents. Also noted speed cushions are being piloted on Upper Amsterdam. LB offered to reach out to Park wrt obscured “Stop ahead” sign.
- 3. John Collado Street Co-Naming.** Joshua Lopez (nephew) and anti-war group called ANSWER have been advocating for this street co-naming for John Collado, who was shot by NYPD officer in September 2011 while trying to de-escalate a situation on the street. NYPD settled for \$5.5 million, although the officer who acted alone continues to serve. Co-naming would be northeast corner Dyckman & Post.
  - a. D Nabavian addressed challenges of this co-naming as it relates to aspects that don’t fit neatly in co-naming guidelines, J Mazur and Jim Berlin spoke eloquently in favor. M Anderson spoke about her initial concerns but how the discussion was persuasive.
  - b. Committee voted 6-0 in favor. CB12 Board members voted one in favor (Baez), one abstain (Bosley).
