At the General Meeting on Tuesday, December 20th, 2022, with a vote of 26 in favor, 5 opposed, 1 abstention, and 1 conflict of interest, Community Board 12, Manhattan, passed a resolution of **No Objection** to the New York State Liquor Authority for a New On-Premises Liquor License to Casa Latina Restaurant LLC.

Whereas, Casa Latina Restaurant LLC – 1447-57 Saint Nicholas (bet 182nd & 183rd Street) New York, NY 10033, has duly notified Community Board 12 Manhattan of its intention to file a new On-Premise Liquor License; and

Whereas, the Licensing Committee met on December 13th, 2022, to hear comments from the community and the precinct regarding this establishment's application for a New On-Premises Liquor License. This application was approved in June 2022. However, the owner came back to fix a typo on the corporation from "Casa Latino" to "Casa Latina." The committee agreed to approve the previous resolution which follows below; and

Whereas, the establishment's storefront is located on the street level of a six (6) story commercial and residential building; and

Whereas, the restaurant will operate with 40 employees, with 32 tables and 96 chairs and 12 bar stools with a capacity of 256 people, restaurant hours of operation are: Monday through Wednesday from 2:00 pm to 4:00 am, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 12:00 noon to 4:00 am and Sunday from 12:00 noon to 2:00 am; and

Whereas, the method of operations is a jukebox, karaoke, jazz live music, DJ, and recorded music only, and the space will be effectively soundproofed, and a sound limiter be installed; and

Whereas, members of the community, Licensing, and Community Board members expressed their support to see this establishment open; and

Whereas, the 34th Precinct was not present at the time the applicant was introduced to the committee; and

Whereas, the new owner and manager have had over 18 years of operating restaurants in the community. One resident was concerned about possible noise issues with the new establishment. The owner indicated that the establishment is soundproofed and has installed a sound limiter. The Chair has worked with the manager to rectify some issues affecting businesses in the area; and

Whereas, the owner agreed to the following stipulations: 1) Display a "No Double Parking" sign and 2) a phone number to be displayed in case neighbors or patrons have any issues; therefore be it

Resolved, that Community Board 12, Manhattan, **Does Not Object** to the New York State Liquor Authority for a New On-Premises Liquor License to Casa Latina Restaurant LLC.
