At the General Meeting on Tuesday, December 17, 2019, with a vote of 40 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstention, Community Board 12 Manhattan, passed a resolution supporting the application by Columbia University Irving Medical Center for a revocable consent to construct and maintain telecommunications conduits at 701 W. 168th Street and 104 Haven Avenue; and, requesting that any excavation in the street and disruption of parking and traffic lanes be coordinated with the ongoing water main replacement project. This is a final confirmation of the prior emergency letter of no objection sent to you on December 5, 2019, no objecting to the Telecommunication conduit by the petitioner The Trustee of Columbia University in the City of New York the site location at 701 West 168th Street and 104 Haven Ave. Manhattan, NY 10032.
