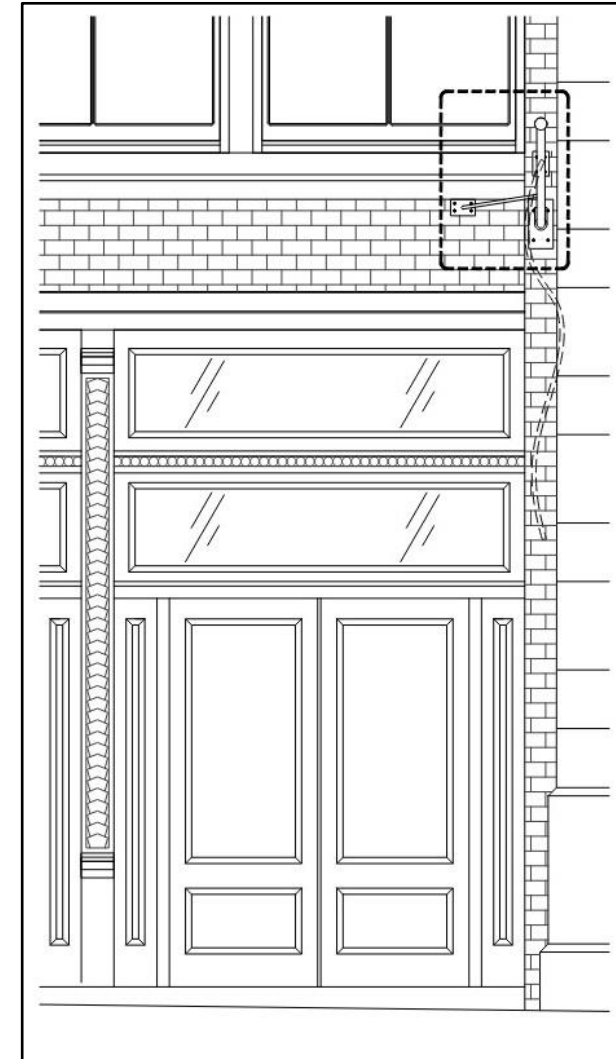

Dear Mr. Bittenbinder:

Pursuant to Section 25-307 (formerly 207-6.0) of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, the Landmarks Preservation Commission at the Executive Session following the Public Hearing of November 24, 1987 voted to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness for facade work at the subject premises, as put forward in your application dated September 23, 1987.

The proposed work includes the restoration and painting of both cornices, the restoration and repointing of all masonry on both facades, the restoration of all wood sash on both facades, alterations to the southernmost ground floor storefront on the Wooster Street facade, and the installation of flagpoles and banners on both facades as described in a letter dated September 15, 1987; window and cornice specifications dated received November 11, 1987; boards B-1 through B-17 presented at the Public Hearing and Executive Session; and in a letter and two elevation drawings dated March 30, 1988. All material was submitted by WYS Design Partnership.

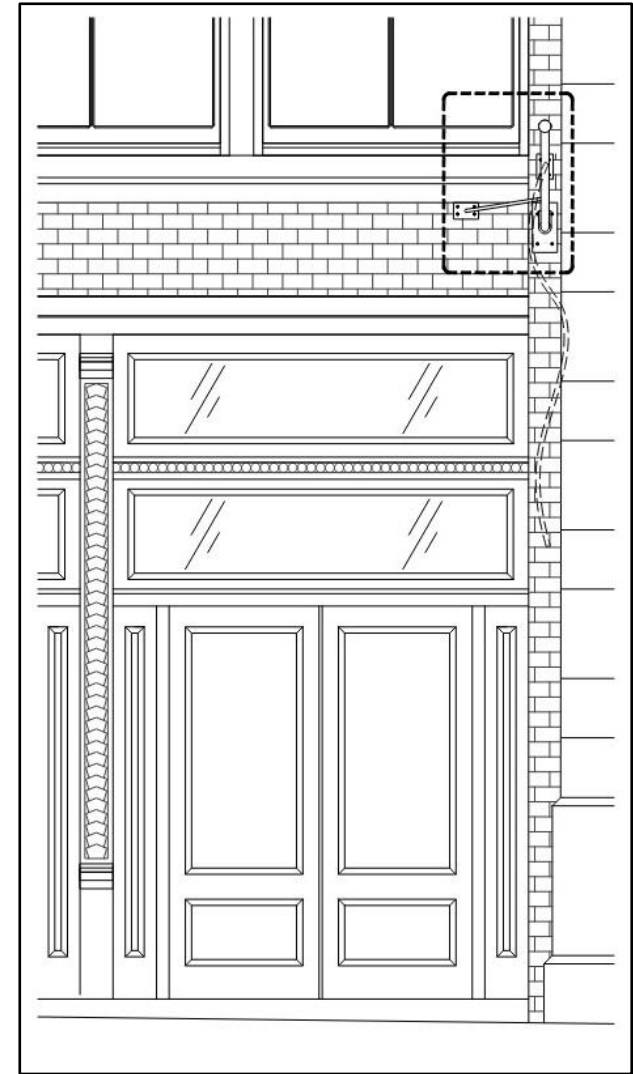

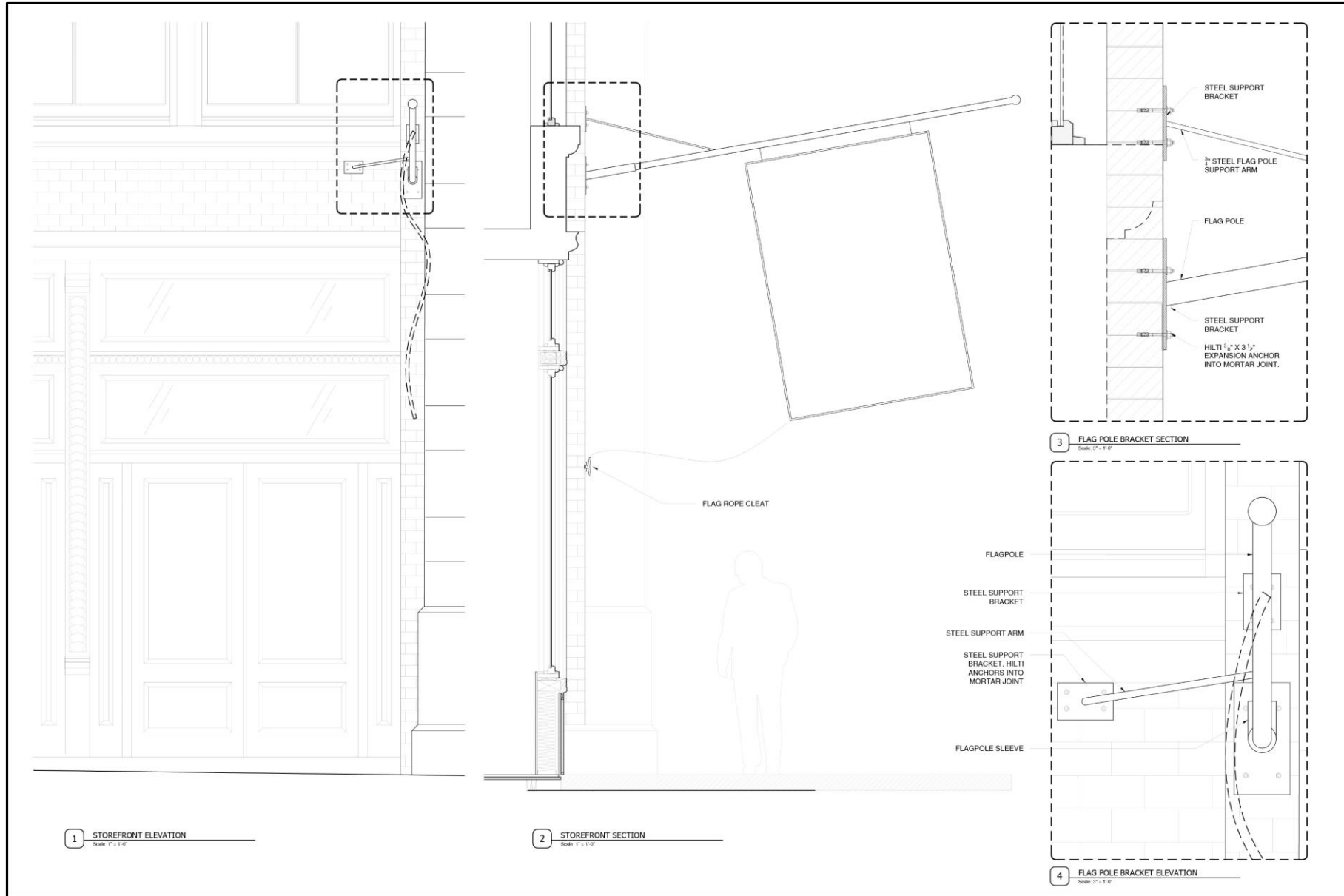

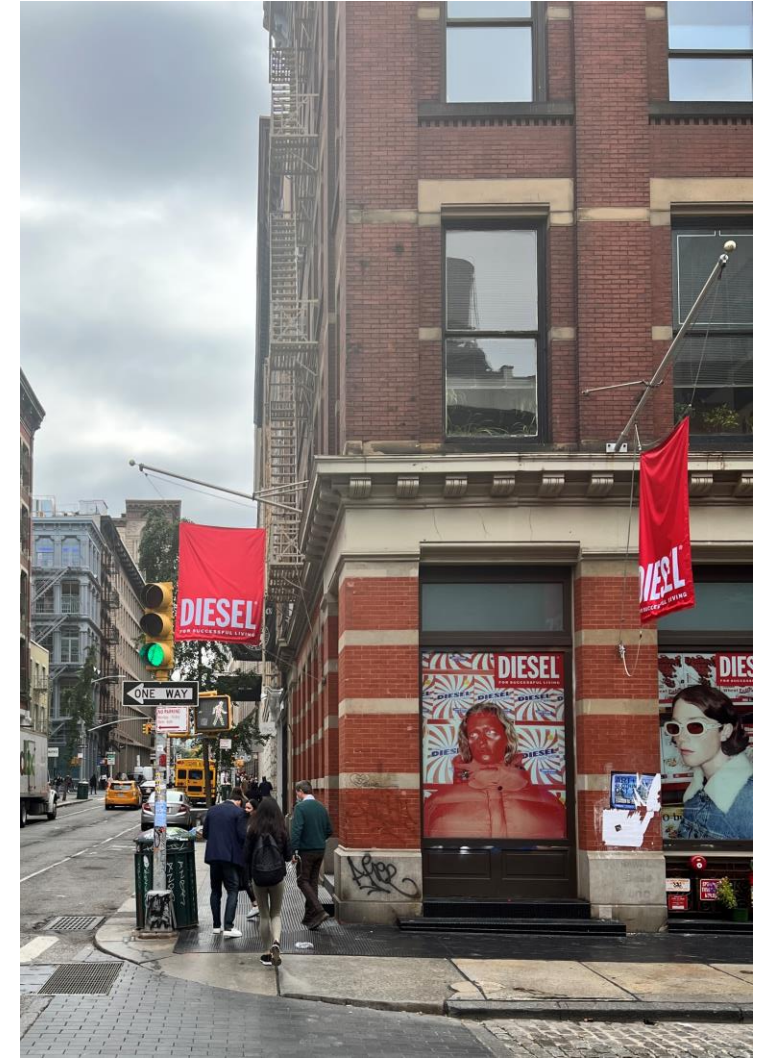
