#### Sidewalk Cafes








#### Overview

- Continue current practices
- Still review anything attached to the building or paving
  - Awnings or coverings
  - Light fixtures
  - Conduit







#### **Current Practice**

- Began to be installed during pandemic
- Temporarily permitted through emergency order
- LPC generally did not review








#### Overview

- Extensive siting criteria
- Detailed design criteria



# Proposed Regulatory Approach

Landmarks Preservation

- No LPC permit required if setup meets DOT's siting and design criteria.
- LPC permit required for electrical conduit extending from the building to the cafe
