- 10 Alcoholic beverages will be sold, consumed or distributed at this event. **This will require eligible restaurants/businesses/caterers to obtain a Temporary Beer and Wine Permit from the NYS Liquor Authority.**
- 11 There will be carnival games at this event. **This requires a DCA 30-day Street Fair Vendor permit for each vendor.**
- 12 There will be "Game(s) of Chance" at this event. **This requires that each operator obtain a valid license to conduct a 'Game of Chance' from the Department of Consumer Affairs.**
