At its Full Board meeting on April 23, 2026, Community Board #2, Manhattan (CB2, Man.) adopted the following resolution:

***5/15/26 – The House Tour (Sponsor: SERHANT) – West Broadway (bet. Broome and Spring Streets – performance in front of 372 West Broadway) [Street event – pop-up show]**

Whereas, the applicant did not appear on behalf of this application, and the committee was unable to hear the particulars of this event; now

Whereas, the application proposes a full street closure on West Broadway featuring a well-known band during a Friday rush hour, which has the potential to cause significant traffic disruption and a public safety risk; now

Therefore Be It Resolved that CB2, Man. recommends **denial** of **The House Tour (Sponsor: SERHANT)**.

Vote: Unanimous, with 36 Board members in favor.

We respectfully request that your agency take action consistent with the positions expressed in the above.
