Program Requirements

- Must be 18-24 years old
- State/City ID or US Passport
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of Address (Within the past 6 months)
- Pre-test reading score of **501** required for **Pre-HSE track**
- Pre-test reading score of **536** required for **HSE track**



Program Benefits

- GED Diploma
- Incentives for Milestones
- Transportation Provided
- **Guaranteed stipend (if class hours are met)** for eligible students accepted into **Pre-HSE**
- **Guaranteed paid Internship** placement if accepted into **HSE**



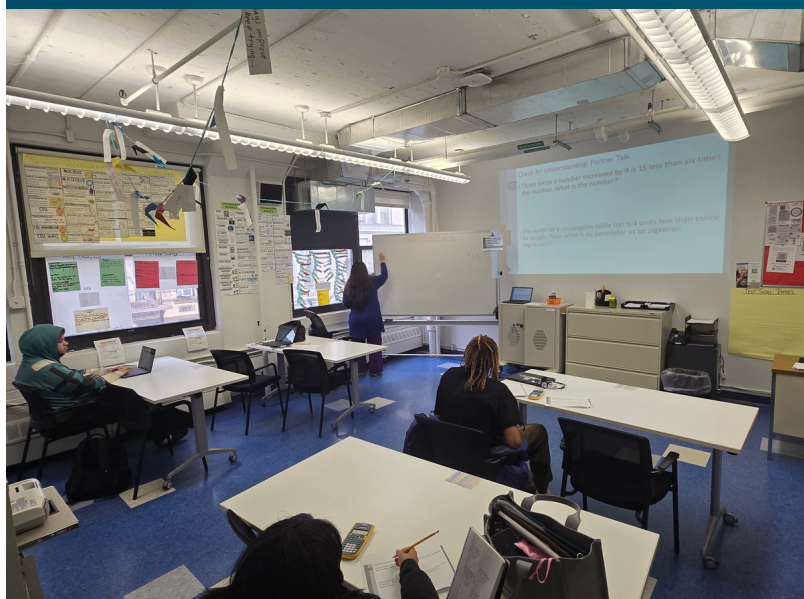

Program Timeline

Located at our Manhattan Youth Center, the program offers comprehensive GED test prep, hands-on training, paid internships, and industry-recognized certifications. Graduates leave equipped with the knowledge and experience to pursue higher education, job opportunities, and long-term career growth.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be between 18-24 years
- Must have a Social Security Card
- State ID / City ID or US Passport
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of NYC Residency (Must be dated within the last 6 months)

- Paid incentives for milestone completion

- **Paid Internship for HSE Track:** 250 hours total at \$18/hour (approx. 25 hours/week)
- **Weekly Stipend for Pre-HSE Track:** Earn \$240/week (must attend at least 14 hours of programming)

Enrollment Process

1. **Sign Up** – Complete the Interest Form and become a Door Member at our Manhattan Youth Center. Walk-in hours: Monday–Friday, 2 PM–5 PM.
2. **Pre-Screening** – We'll call to check your eligibility.
3. **Attend Mandatory Virtual Info Session** – Learn about the program, expectations, and timeline. **(BY INVITE ONLY)**
4. **Submit Documents** – Provide the required documentation.
5. **Intake Session** – Attend a one-day intake to complete paperwork and take the TABE Math/Reading assessment
6. **Interview** – Meet with a program staff to assess program alignment and readiness
7. **Induction!** – Attend orientation week and get ready to earn your GED!
