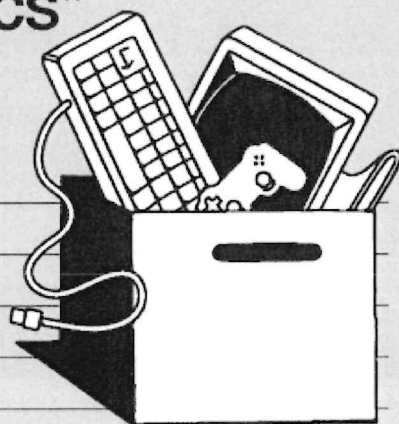

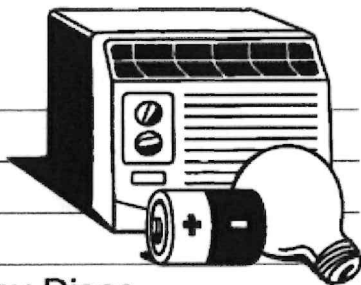

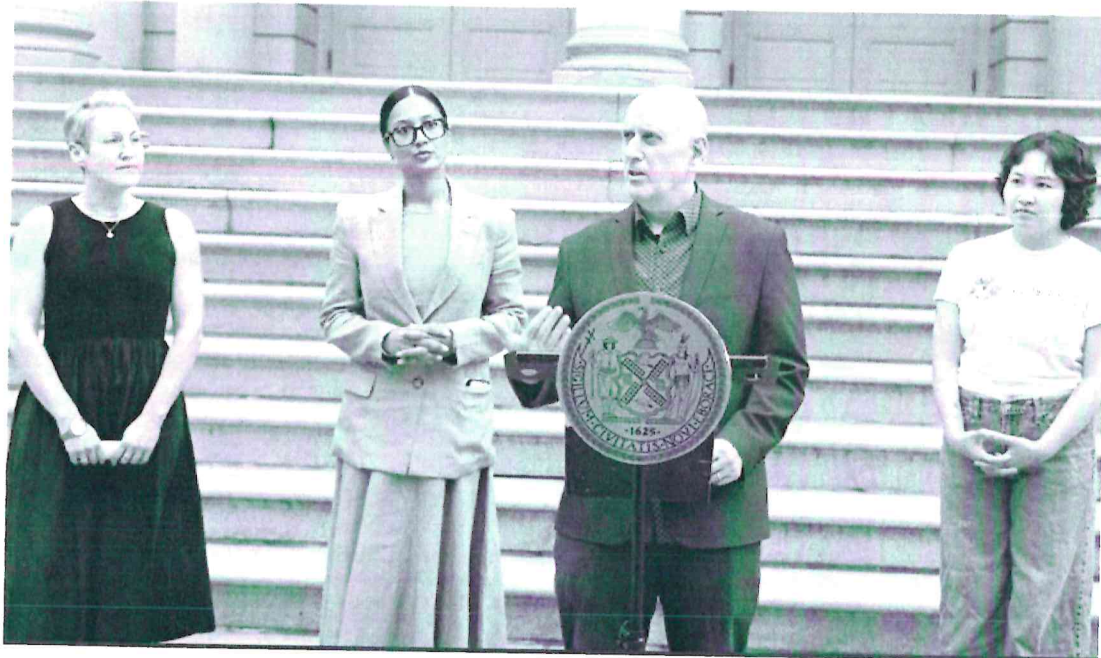




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Rally Against Unlicensed Pet Boarding Facilities

When New Yorkers board their pets, they deserve peace of mind to know that they will be taken care of. Tragically, Lindsay's dog Penny was killed by another dog at an unlicensed boarding location. Ahead of today's Stated Meeting, I stood with Council Member Hanif and Voters for Animal Rights to uplift Lindsey's story and to announce the introduction of my bill that will create a map of licensed pet boarding facilities and provide an education campaign on the dangers of unlicensed locations. No one should have to go through what Lindsay has gone through, and we will fight to protect our pets with this legislation.

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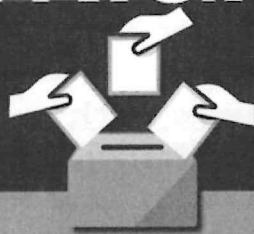
