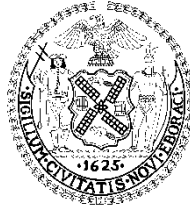

**Whereas**,


- a. the applicants and several members of the Holy Trinity congregation appeared and no members of the community appeared in opposition, and
