### **FYI/Renewal Street Activities:**

1. **1/7/17 & 12/31/17 – St. Patrick’s Old Cathedral Outdoor Market**, Prince St. between Mott and Mulberry St.
2. **2/3/17 & 12/17/17 – St. Anthony Flea Market**, West Houston St. between Thompson St and McDougal St (one member of the public was present to express her concern about crafts fairs and flea markets in general taking over the sidewalks of NYC and asked the Committee to be mindful of this point of view in its future deliberations)
3. **4/1/17 – Saint Joseph’s Church** – Washington Place Festival, Washington Place between 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Grove Street
4. **see note below.**
5. **5/7/17 & 6/4/17 – Washington Square Outdoor Art Exhibit**, University Place between Waverly Place and E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street
6. **9/2/17 & 9/10/17 – Washington Square Outdoor Art Exhibit**, University Place between Waverly Place and E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street

**Therefore Be It Resolved** that the committee **Recommends Approval** of the foregoing street activity renewal applications.
