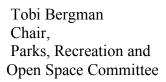
On November 18, 2010, Community Board 2 Manhattan (CB2) passed a resolution concerning the city-owned parkland strips on Mercer Street, LaGuardia Place, Bleecker and W. 3rd Streets on the three Superblocks. The resolution asks New York University to remove any transfer of publicly owned land to private ownership from its development proposals and ULURP application, and to cease blocking applications to transfer the land to the Parks Department.

CB2 joined with Congressman Jerrold Nadler, Borough President Scott Stringer, State Senator Thomas Duane, State Assemblywoman Deborah Glick, City Council Member Margaret Chin, and the larger Greenwich Village community, at a rally on December 5th. We are all united in our affirmation that public land should stay in the public domain.

We would appreciate your prompt response and hope it will include an announcement that NYU no longer seeks to acquire the city-owned parkland strips. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.
