



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

Dear Natalia,

This letter certifies that based upon our acoustical review of the proposed new event space at 617 West 46th Street in Manhattan, and our review of the architect's design drawings, it is our finding that the operation of proposed commercial music systems and performance of any commercial music in the event space shall comply with the noise control requirements of the NYC Administrative Code.

Compliance with paragraph 24-231, Commercial Music, of the NYC Administrative Code requires the commercial tenant to reduce the transmission of music reproduction sound levels to prevent intrusion on residential dwelling units:

§ 24–231 Commercial music. (a) No person shall make or cause or permit to be made or caused any music originating from or in connection with the operation of any commercial establishment or enterprise when the level of sound attributable to such music, as measured inside any receiving property dwelling unit:

(1) is in excess of 42 dB(A) as measured with a sound level meter; or

(2) is in excess of 45 dB in any one-third octave band having a center frequency between 63 hertz and 500 hertz (ANSI bands numbers 18 through 27, Inclusive), in accordance with American National Standards Institute standard S1.6-1984; or

(3) causes a 6 dB(C) or more increase in the total sound level above the ambient sound level as measured in decibels in the "C" weighting network provided that the ambient sound level is in excess of 62 dB(C).

Compliance with NYC Administrative Code § 24–231 (Noise Code) shall be effected by:

- A. Locations of Nearest Residential Buildings
 - 1. The nearest residential property to the east is the 626 11th Avenue building at the corner of 11th Avenue and West 46th Street. The distance to this residential building is 350 feet. Music loudness levels shall be inaudible

inside this property. Music loudness levels shall be limited to comply with § 24–231 of the Noise Code.

- 2. The nearest residential property to the north is the <u>721 11th Avenue</u> building at West 56th Street and 11th Avenue. The distance to this residential building is 1200 feet as-the-crow-flies over the intervening buildings. Music loudness levels shall be inaudible inside this property.
- 3. The nearest residential property to the south is the <u>550 West 45th Street</u> building at West 45th Street and 11th Avenue. The distance to this residential building is 500 feet as-the-crow-flies over the intervening buildings. Music loudness levels shall be inaudible inside this property.
- 4. There are no residential properties to the west.

B. Enclosed Main Dining Room Sound Barrier Construction

The 6th floor Dining Room is a fully enclosed indoor space.

- 1. The exterior walls consist cement masonry units (CMU) and covered with insulated gypsum board on the inside. Exterior walls shall be rated to provide a minimum ASTM Sound Transmission Class rating of STC 55-60 in order to control music sound levels from intruding upon residential dwelling units in the neighborhood.
- 2. Windows shall consist of 1" insulated double glazed units rated to provide an ASTM Sound Transmission Class rating of STC 35 in order to control music sound levels from intruding upon residential dwelling units in the neighborhood. The event space HVAC system has been designed to provide cooling and fresh air ventilation with the need for opening the windows.
- 3. The roof/ceiling assembly shall consist 4" concrete over steel deck and insulated sheetrock finished ceiling. The roof/ceiling assembly walls shall be rated to provide a minimum ASTM Sound Transmission Class rating of STC 60 in order to control music sound levels from intruding upon residential dwelling units in the neighborhood.
- 4. Skylights shall consist of 1" insulated double glazed units rated to provide an ASTM Sound Transmission Class rating of STC 35 in order to control music sound levels from intruding upon residential dwelling units in the neighborhood. The skylights are not operable.



C. Sound Systems Loudness Control Measures

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- 1. The house sound system shall incorporate distributed ceiling loudspeakers that lays out the loudspeakers to be in close proximity to listeners, in order to limit the loudness settings of the speakers.
- 2. The house sound systems shall incorporate audio processing devices to regulate the overall loudness levels. Audio processing devices will include:
 - a. dbx Professional 1066 Compressor/Limiter to automatically limit loudness levels to preset limits established by hotel management.
 - b. dbx Professional 231 Dual 31-Band Graphic Equalizer to attenuate the music program's bass frequency peaks to control intrusive noise transmission to the outdoors.
 - c. In addition to the audio processing devices, the event facility management shall purchase and employ the regular use of a professional sound level meter to monitor music reproduction sound levels. A recommended sound level meter is the Quest Technologies Model 2100 Sound Level Meter.
 - 3. The house sound system and portable sound system used for events shall be limited to approximately 100 dBC decibel loudness, or as required to comply with paragraph 24-231 of the noise code. If the noise levels at residential dwelling units exceed the noise code limits, the levels shall be turned down accordingly.


In conclusion, commercial music operation within the event space shall comply with the NYC Noise Code and shall not be intrusive to residential dwelling units in the neighborhood.
