# Re: Proposal for Staff at 123 West 18<sup>th</sup> Street

Dear Chair Carroll:

At its regularly scheduled Full Board meeting on March 6<sup>th</sup>, Manhattan Community Board 4 (CB4), voted 39 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstaining and 0 present but not eligible to vote to recommend approval with two conditions of an application for a staff at 123 West 18<sup>th</sup> Street. This recommendation reflects the vote of its Chelsea Land Use Committee at its February 21<sup>st</sup> meeting after a duly noticed public hearing at the committee meeting.

## Background

The building at 123 West 18<sup>th</sup> Street is located in the Ladies Mile Historic District. The proposed silver staff, which requires Landmarks Preservation Commission approval, would be located on the front of the building. It is intended to identify the Metropolitan Pavilion, which offers event spaces and production services. The staff would be located under a third floor window and would project four feet over the sidewalk. The staff is designed to display a banner three feet by five feet. The banner would be attached to the facade by a wire. According to the applicant there are 47 banners in the Ladies Mile Historic District. The applicant provided photos of all these banners.

## **CB4 Recommendation**

CB4 finds the proposed staff consistent with other staffs in the Ladies Mile Historic District and does not envision any negative impact on the neighborhood. CB4 recommends approval of the

proposed staff on the condition that the size of the banner be no larger than three feet by five feet and that the banner identifies the Metropolitan Pavilion or the events taking place there.
