

Snap Peas w/ Lemon

Sugar Sprint: Not a carnival race, but a snappy variety of spring pea. (Although you might be tempted to chase them down at any opportunity.) Sugar Sprints are the first crop we plant on the Dig Inn Farm. As the winter season breaks and the black dirt becomes malleable, seeds are sewn. At a few inches tall, they're given a stake in the ground and a trellis above, around which their straggly, ambitious tendrils will eventually wrap. The sweet, stringless pods are close to perfect raw, right off the vine. True sublimity comes with a dusting of Maldon salt, a good pour of olive oil, and a squeeze of lemon. Which is precisely how you'll find them here, on the market line, for their short and sweet season.

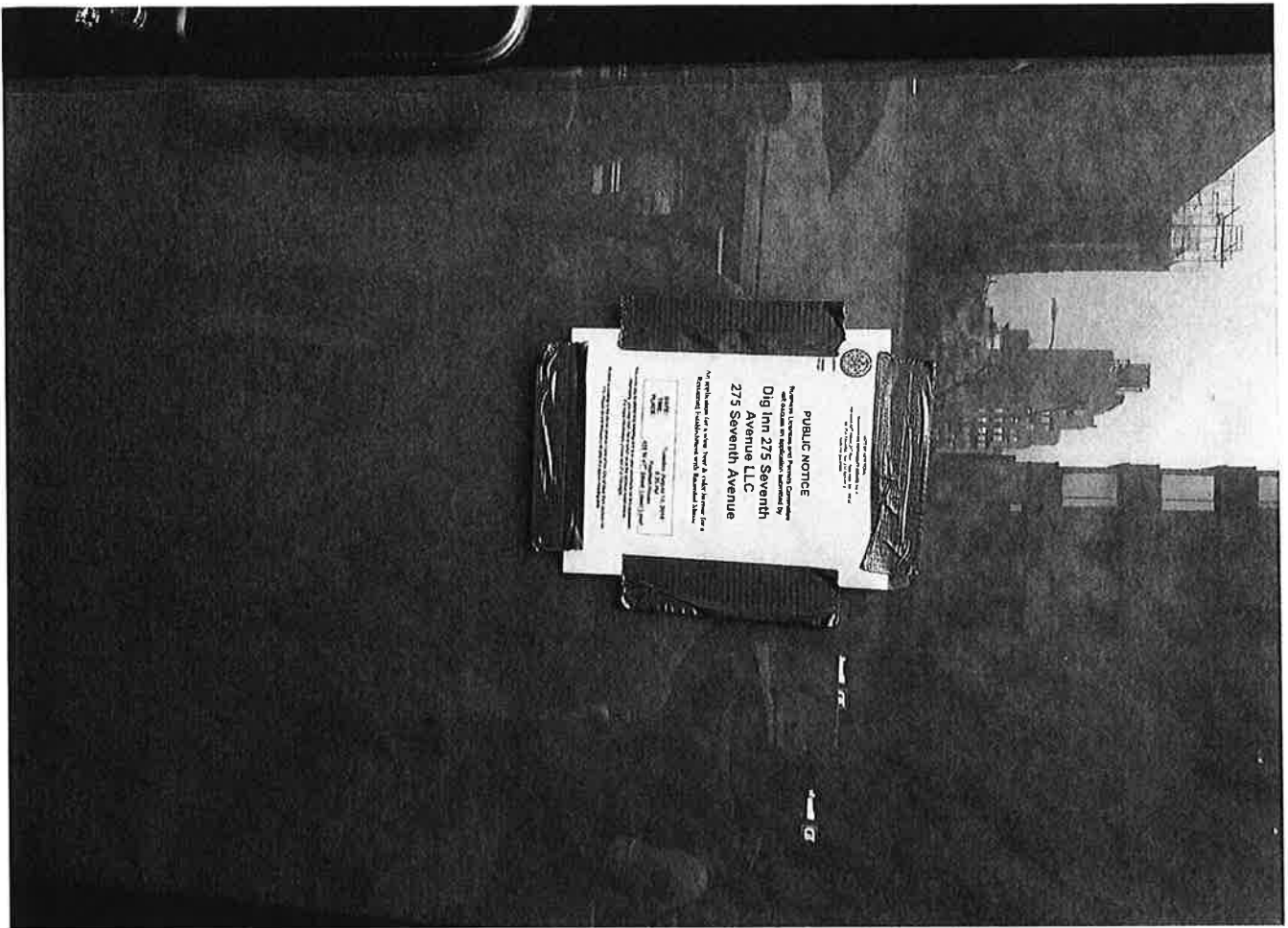

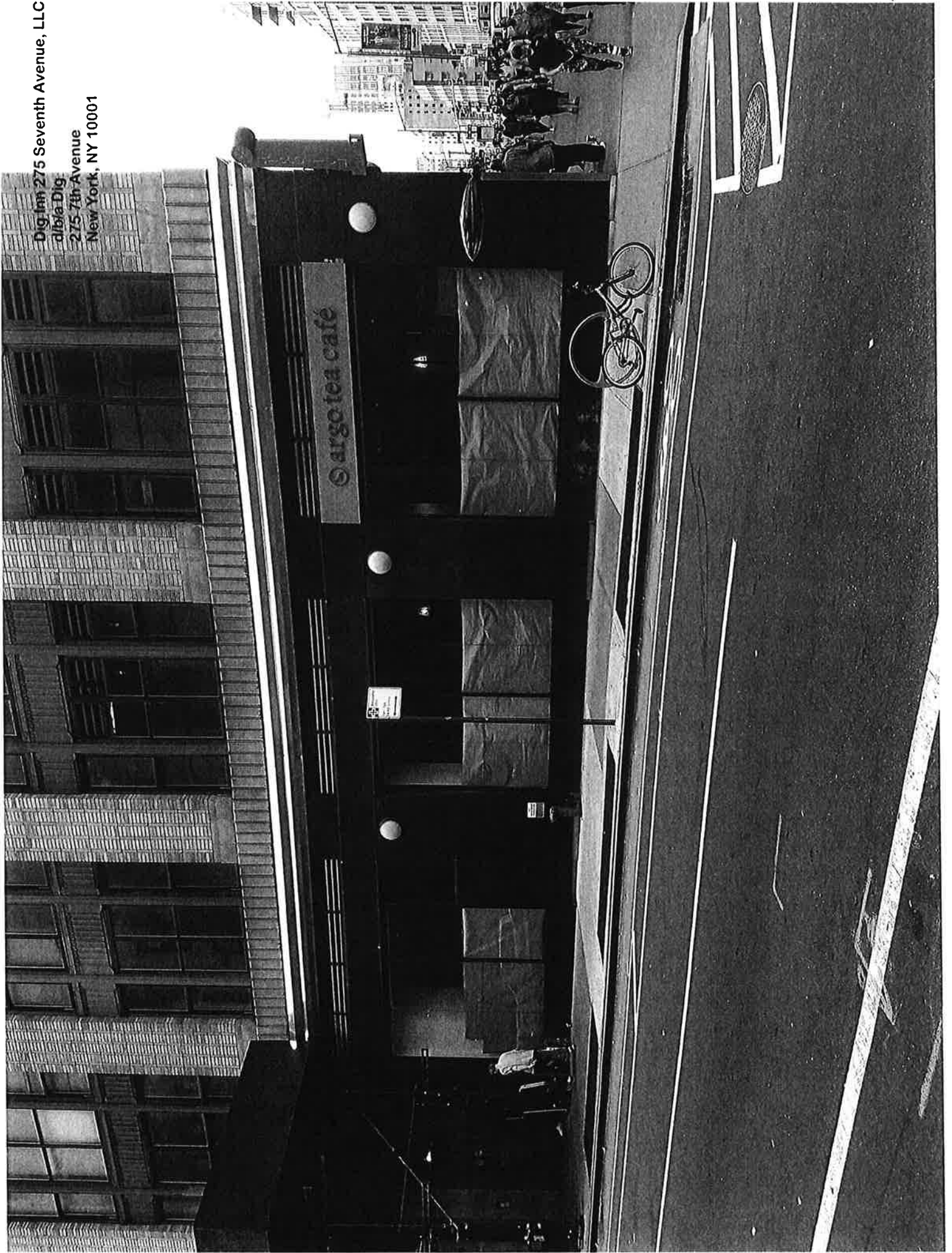
