## Wrecking Club Safety Outline

All of our management team including managing members will take an on-premise ATAP course and be TIPS certified. This will enable us to better screen customers for responsible alcohol consumption as well as better equip us properly trained staff members.

How does breaking stuff work?

1. -Once a customer books an appointment they will be given a link to a waiver that has our safety video imbedded in it. Our safety waiver must be filled out by every participant and cannot be electronically signed with out the participant finishing the safety video.
2. -Once the participants arrive:
  - a. We provide each participant with ALL required safety gear.
  - b. All safety rules are explained again in person right before the session begins.
  - c. Participants can begin and are intermittently supervised through live cameras to ensure all rules are being followed.
  - d. **\*\*We have a ZERO tolerance policy on the safety rules. One strike and session is over.\*\***

How many people are allowed in a room at one time?

1. There are six people allowed in the Wrecking Club rooms at one time TOTAL.
2. Only two people are allowed to be Wrecking at a time.

What is the ratio of Wrecking participants to staff members?

1. Each group will have their own staff member assigned to them. That gives a ratio of participants to staff of 6 to 1.

What tools will participants be using?

1. Participants are only allowed to use baseball bats, crow bars, and one sledge hammer per room.
2. We only allow blunt tools.
3. Tools are NEVER allowed to be taken out of the room.

Will alcohol be allowed in the Wrecking Club room?

1. No food or alcohol is be allowed in the Wrecking Club room.
2. ANY and ALL patrons who are visibly intoxicated will not be allowed to participant under any circumstances nor will they continue to be served.

## Safety regulations

The Wrecking Club has been functioning since June of 2016 and has maintained an absolute perfect safety record. We hold ourselves, our staff, and our participants to the highest safety standards. Through our experience in this unique activity we have developed safety regulations that ensure participant safety and they are strictly enforced. Please see the following safety regulations:

Before each session begins:

1. Each participant is required to watch a safety video that illustrates and verbally explains all rules.
2. Participants are checked for closed toed shoes, sufficient long sleeves, and sufficient long pants.
3. Participants are then provided protective eyewear (or hard had visor), hard hat, and construction gloves.
4. If participants are at the throwing range provided protective eyewear is required at all times.

Once in the Wrecking Club Room:

1. All safety rules are repeated and demonstrated for a second time by a staff member.
2. In room rules are:
  - a. 2 participants MAX smashing at a time.
  - b. ALL safety gear must remain on the entire time.
  - c. Throwing is only permitted down range. There is a designated wall that participants are allowed to throw items against.
3. Staff member will intermittently and frequently check the live camera to ensure all rules are being followed.
4. No tools are allowed to leave the room under any circumstances.


After session:

1. A staff member cleans and restocks the room.
2. Debris is sorted for recycling.
3. A staff member will inspect the tools to ensure safe condition.

### First Aid

1. The location will be equipped with a level C first aid kit
2. All customer facing staff and mangers will be certified in First Aid/CPR/AED.

\*Out of all of the establishments like this across the country we have the most safety requirements which is why our safety record is so clean.





FIRST FLOOR PLAN
