The installation was requested by Chelsea residents who, in particular, voiced concerns about children crossing from the mid-block daycare facility to the park across the street. The street is subject to speeding vehicles rushing to make the light, although truck traffic is not an issue as it is on other blocks, due to the change in traffic direction at Tenth Avenue.

At its May 2<sup>nd</sup> Full Board Meeting, MCB4 voted in support of the installation of two speed humps for West 20<sup>th</sup> Street with a vote of 43 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining, and 0 present but not eligible to vote.

We look forward to DOT installing such features as soon as feasible.
