## **Re: Proposed Improvements to the Eighth Avenue Corridor from 38<sup>th</sup>-45<sup>th</sup> Streets**

Dear Mr. Pincar,

Thank you for the presentation of much-needed improvements to this corridor. As a signal of our enthusiastic endorsement of this proposal, we would like to see the improvement corridor extended from West 34<sup>th</sup> to West 48<sup>th</sup> Streets. To build on the success of the presented approach, Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) at its July 24<sup>th</sup> Full Board meeting, voted by 35 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining and 0 present but not eligible to vote, on the following suggestions:

- A curb extension at the southwest corner of 40<sup>th</sup> Street. This corner is subject to pedestrian crowding due to an extremely busy subway exit.
- An increased red arrow time for the split-phase LPI at 40<sup>th</sup> Street, west side of Eighth Avenue, to avoid that turning buses block the bike lane while yielding to pedestrians crossing Eighth Avenue.
- Added markings in the travel lane of West 39<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Eighth Avenue to induce vehicles to merge into a single lane before the intersection and reduce bike lane obstruction.
- A reduction of green signal time at West 39<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Eighth Avenue, in order to mitigate traffic overflow that regularly blocks pedestrian crossing and bike lane movement.
- Resurfacing of the bike lane from West 34<sup>th</sup> to West 45<sup>th</sup> Streets, it is in poor condition and has several dangerous potholes.

- Request that the Port Authority remove the obsolescent taxi booth on the southwest corner of Eighth Avenue and West 41<sup>st</sup> Street and consider alternate locations for the taxi stand along Eighth Avenue.
- Request that the MTA replace the subway grates on the west sidewalk from West 38<sup>th</sup> Street to West 40<sup>th</sup> Street (total length of 100-ft). These grates are in poor condition and not walkable, effectively reducing the walk lane capacity by 40%.

We are anxious to see the installation of these improvements. Please let us know when they will be implemented.
