As you are well aware, we are concerned about the effects of fireworks displays on the surrounding Hell's Kitchen neighborhood. Whenever there is a fireworks display in our neighborhoods, we send out notifications, so residents are not surprised by the noise after dark.

However, in order to send this notification in a timely fashion, we must know about the fireworks displays that are scheduled to take place. As the shooting of fireworks requires permits from the FDNY, we cannot accept that the only notification we received was mere hours before the event.

We urge both of your organizations to take whatever steps necessary to provide MCB4 with advance notice whenever events that include fireworks will be scheduled. At MCB4's July 25th Full Board meeting, this request was voted on with 29 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining and 0 present but not eligible to vote.
