Re: Newsstand Application 7201-2019-ANWS North East Corner of 34th Street and Tenth Avenue, in front of 461 West 34th Street

Dear Commissioner Salas and Borough Commissioner Pincar,

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4), at its July 24th Full Board meeting, voted to <u>deny</u> this application by a vote of 35 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstaining, and 0 present but not eligible to vote.

The applicant did not attend the July 17th meeting of MCB4's Transportation Planning Committee to present the application and introduce themselves to our community.

We oppose the requested location, which is located on a relatively narrow sidewalk (15') leaving the bare minimum 9'-6" of pedestrian right of way. It would impede pedestrian flow, both current and anticipated, with the development of several high-rise commercial and residential properties to the west of this intersection. It is estimated that an additional 40,000 people will work in these developments, and an additional 4,000 residential units will be completed in the near term.
