## Dear Chairman Rosen:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends <u>denial</u> of an upgrade from a restaurant wine and beer license to a full liquor license for Renebruno Inc. d/b/a La Cucaracha, <u>unless</u> the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of the method of operation for this establishment:

- 1) Hours of operation will be no earlier than 12:00 noon and no later than 4:00 a.m. Monday through Friday and no earlier than 10:00 a.m. and no later than 4:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- 2) The establishment will have a capacity of no more than 74 with no more than 12 tables and 48 seats and only one bar with no seats.
- 3) Only soft background music will be played and all doors and windows will be kept closed when music is being played.
- 4) The applicant is not applying for a cabaret license with this current application.
- 5) There will be no use of any outdoor spaces (rooftop, patio or sidewalk café) at this time for the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- 6) There will be absolutely no use of delivery bikes.
- 7) There will be French doors and/or windows that open to the street front. Applicant has agreed to close them by 10:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. They will also be closed whenever amplified sound is played inside, as per law.
- 8) Applicant agreed to not install a storm vestibule enclosure that will project more than 18 inches as per DOB code. Storm enclosures can only be used between November 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 9) Kitchen exhaust will exit through ventilation above the highest floor of surrounding buildings and be constructed in a manner to not disturb neighboring residents or offices. Additionally it will be compliant with NY DOB code.

A signed copy of the stipulations and community agreements is enclosed. This application is for an existing restaurant.
