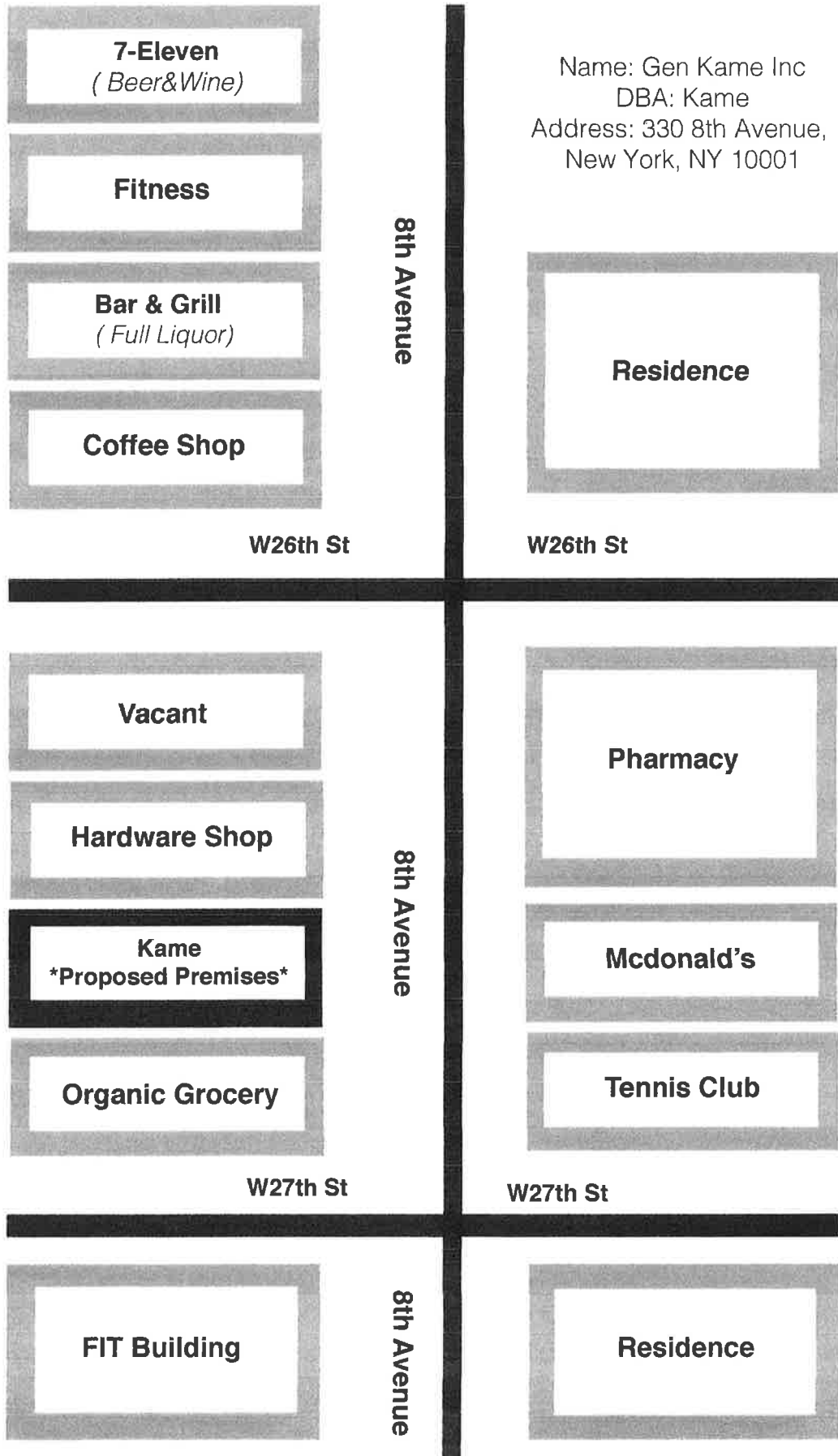

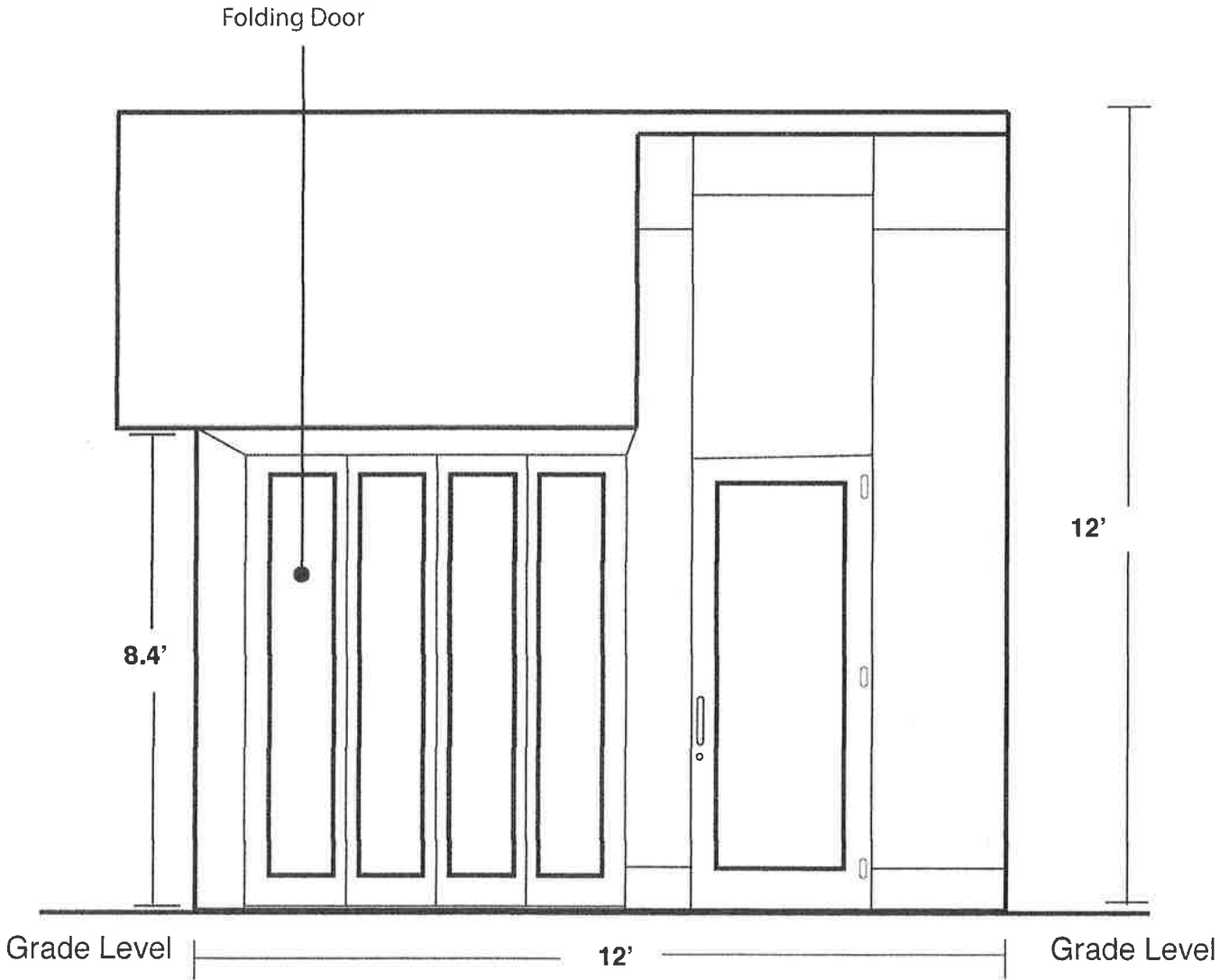

A Block Plot Diagram



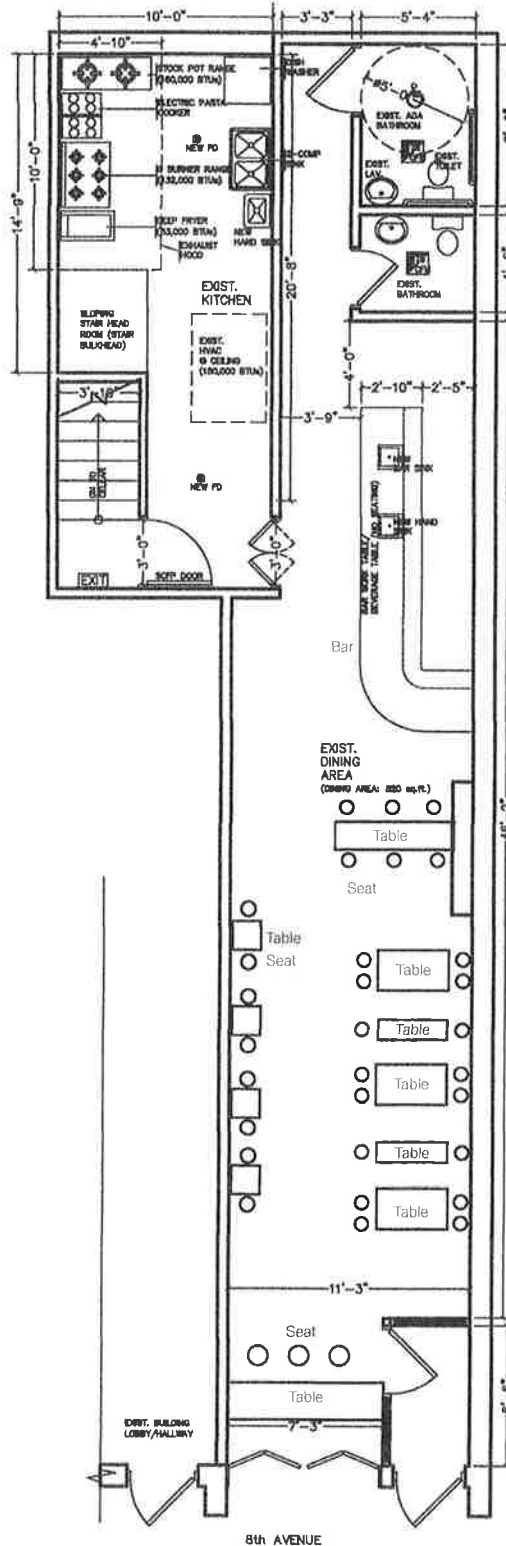
Font Elevation Diagram

Floor Plan

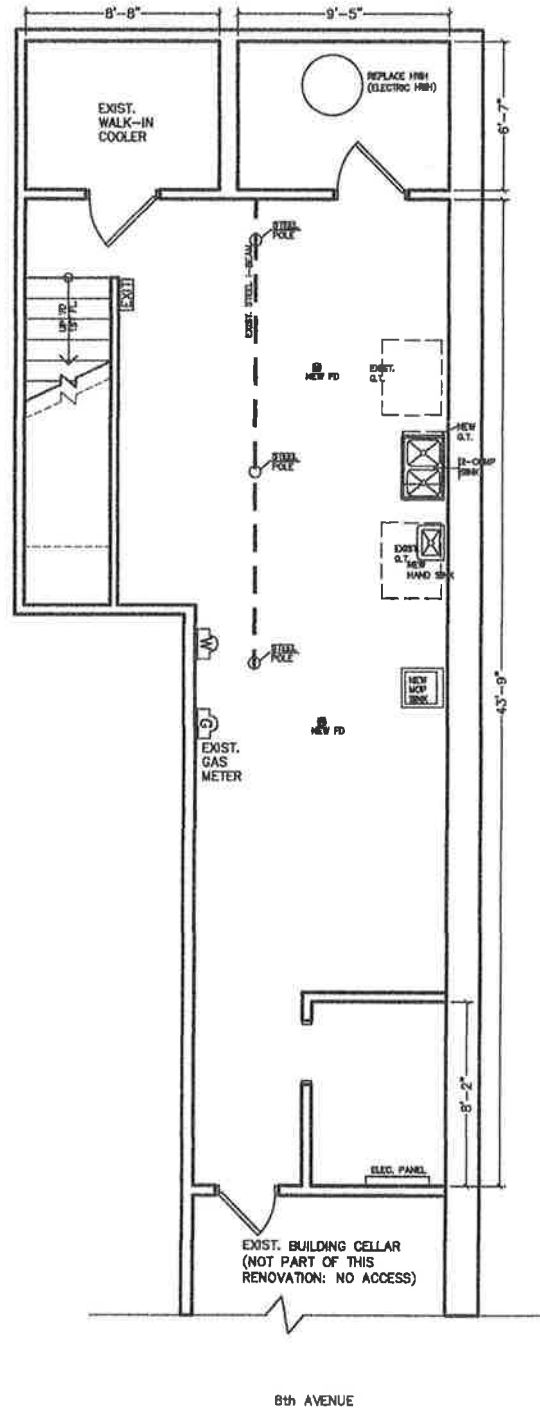
Interior Ground Floor
