**Re: Missing Road Markings**

Dear Commissioner Sanchez:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (CB4) would like to first thank you and your staff for the number of full street repavings that were done in our district this past fall. However, on inspection, CB4 did notice that the road markings have yet to be repainted. CB4 respectfully requests that DOT replace the missing road markings from the following intersections:

- Pedestrian Crossing at West 37th Street from 8th – 10th Avenues
- Pedestrian Crossing at West 39th Street from 8th – 10th Avenues
- Pedestrian Crossing at West 41st Street from 8th – 10th Avenues
- Curb Extension at West 41st Street and 9th Avenue
- West 35th Street should be evaluated for missing markings

Replacing the missing pedestrian crossings and curb extensions will ensure the safety of both pedestrians and drivers in our district.

This is in response to your correspondence requesting the installation and refurbishment of faded and missing markings at the following locations in Manhattan:

- W 37<sup>th</sup> St from 8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues – crosswalk markings
- W 39<sup>th</sup> St from 8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues – crosswalk markings
- W 41<sup>st</sup> St from 8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues – crosswalk markings
- W 41<sup>st</sup> St @ 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue – curb extension
- W 35<sup>th</sup> St - evaluate markings

Please be advised that our Highway Design Unit has investigated your request and determined that this work is warranted. As a result a work order has been submitted to our contractor to include this among our Spring 2018, thermoplastic markings contracts.
