Site Survey

At present the restaurant is permitted outdoor dining in a rear courtyard. The courtyard is surrounded by hard reflective surfaces. This includes cement tiles on the ground. Three adjacent brick or cement skim-coated walls, a five-story trio of brick buildings, along with a walkway as you exit the restaurant through a narrow glass paneled door with an aluminum awning above said exit.

Other than some plants and shrubs in planters there is little absorption.

There are fabric umbrellas over many of the outdoor tables. They may absorb some ambient conversation, but they cannot prevent sound from leaving the courtyard space.

The request to bring down the ambient noises from diners and servers is desired.

Acoustical recommendations

1) The doorway to exit the rear of the restaurant is underperforming being too narrow, swings the wrong way, and has an aluminum awning above it. This is not only very close to the impacted complaining neighbor, but it is also the point source for lots of noise as servers negotiate and exit carrying plates to the diners outside. As well as bring back dirty plates and utensils back inside.

It was mentioned to me that a French-door was to be cut into the brick wall to the right of the narrow door. This will create plenty of noise during construction but afterwards eliminate the server noise carrying food outside. Remove the aluminum awning over this doorway completely as well.

- 2) The ground covering of cement tiles must be covered by outdoor carpet, you will have to select one which is not slippery if wet. The goal is to change a reflective surface to an absorbing surface.
- 3) Presently there are several 5-6' tall shrubs, evergreen shrubs which grow tall and narrow over time. Purchase as many as you can fit and line them around the brick walls that make up three of perimeter walls. On the edge of the patio where the stairs go down to the five-story buildings, place as many tall shrubs or trees which you can walk thru your restaurant. You may have to wait until you have the new French-door opening.
- 4) Acoustical panels designed for outdoor wet environments will be quoted at a future date. The factory has closed for summer holiday. There will also be a long lead time for arrival. In the meantime it is best to perform all of the above recommendations as soon as possible.

Conclusion

A panel-based acoustical solution will not bring down the ambient noise levels outside in the courtyard without FIRST performing all of the suggestions above. Immediately purchase all the shrubs and or trees if possible. Cover the cement tiles with carpet and or rubber, keep in mind rain has to drain through it. Install the new doorway, and remove the aluminum awning.


