Homeless Assistance Toolkit

Temporary Hotel Shelters:

Due to COVID-19, the Department of Homeless Services (DHS) moved a number of their clients sheltering in congregate care shelters to hotels throughout the City, including the Community District Four area. Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) has a long track record of welcoming such facilities into our neighborhoods. However, MCB4 recognizes that there can be public safety and quality of life issues related to social service facilities.

What MCB4 is doing:

MCB4 meets on a monthly basis with the Department of Homeless Services and the shelter providers to review community concerns and provider reports. In addition, MCB4 meets with Street Homeless Outreach Provider and other local services providers on a bimonthly basis.

MCB4 has a neighborhood reporting form which will assist in resolving community concerns and complaints.
