

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



My name is Sophie Serrano and I am removing my restaurant, Counter & Bodega, from 266 West 23rd Street to 216 Seventh Avenue NY. NY. I operated my business for nearly two years before the pandemic hit, but this new location is much better suited for my needs. These premises were formerly Zagara Restaurant. I believe that this restaurant serves the public interest, because:

- 1. The neighborhood is not over saturated with liquor licenses
