




INTERIOR DIAGRAM - 1st Floor (Proposed) 312 West 58th Street New York, NY July 6, 2021



Dear Manhattan Community Board 4:

The following is our public interest statement for the above referenced location.

DM 58 LLC (d/b/a TBD), respectfully submits the following:

- a) The number, classes and character of licenses in proximity to the location.
 - According to the independent survey of Landess-Simon, Inc, included with the
 application there are 20 premises with On-Premises licenses within 500' of the
 location. It is unclear whether these licenses are full liquor, or limited to beer,
 wine and cider.
- b) Evidence that all necessary licenses and permits have been obtained.
 - DM 58 LLC aims to principally conduct a cosmetic facelift to a former premises (Gleason's Bar) therefore our architect/designer has determined that no building permits are required. The remodel will consist of paintwork, cleaning, some minor repairs, new light fixtures, kitchen equipment, furniture. The location has obtained its New York State Certificate of Authority to Collect Sales Tax and has applied for its New York City Department of Health & Mental Hygiene Food Permit. The premises will diligently apply for the NYC Open Streets program once the DOH permit has been obtained.
- c) Effect of the grant of the license on vehicular traffic and parking.

- There will be no effect on vehicular traffic and parking. As stated earlier, the location held a prior license under the name of Gleason's Bar. which had no issues with traffic and parking. 58th Street is not considered a major throughway in the city (unlike 57th and 59th Streets). Moreover, the location is designed as a community server, so pedestrian traffic will be the primary customers. The only effect on parking will be the NYC Open Streets program immediately in front of the premises.
- d) The existing noise level at the location and any increase that would be generated by the proposed premises.
 - The location existed previously as a bar and restaurant since the 1970s (Gleason's, and before that the Coliseum). There has been no change to the size or capacity, therefore there will be no increase of noise level at the location. The location is unaware of any prior noise complaints.
- e) The history of liquor violations and reported criminal activity at the proposed premises.
 - No known history of liquor violations and reported criminal activity at the proposed premises.
- f) Any other factors relevant to determine the public convenience and advantage and public interest of the community.
 - DM 58 LLC is the third venture undertaken by two young professionals who have invested their time and personal finances in the venture. Both applicants are immigrants from Ireland, arriving to New York in 2011. One of the applicants is a lawyer in private practice, in charge of regulatory matters. Any infraction would place his career in jeopardy. The other applicant has designed and managed bars/restaurants his entire career (including building two existing ventures in Brooklyn and Manhattan). The location is well thought out, and designed to serve and get involved with the community. The location intends to be a tremendous

addition to the neighborhood, and a place where people come to relax and unwind
and converse away from loud-music.
