Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) at its November 3rd Full Board meeting by a vote of 43 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstaining, and 0 present but not eligible to vote, supports the application by Beacon School to open to students West 44th Street between Tenth and Eleventh Avenues every weekday during the hours of 10:30am to 3:00pm.

Beacon School has been assigned a cohort of students that exceeds its capacity. The Open Street will allow it to expand its cafeteria space by setting up picnic tables in the street.

P.S. 51, located on the same block, is in support as well. Both schools' students will benefit from a safer environment at dismissal time.
