Just to clarify, we are seeking a new beer, liquor, wine license under our ownership and with recorded music for background entertainment; no DJ and no outdoor/patio/sidewalk activities will be planned. We will have a small patio in the back side of the building which we will operate until 11PM and we are planning to do one or two instrument live jazz music indoors once a week maximum. Our hours of operation will be as follows:

Thu - 11AM to 2AM

I (Shalva) have 6 years of hospitality studies and 8 years of management experience in different restaurants in NYC, Birmingham, UK and Tbilisi, Republic of Georgia. She is the head chef and all the recipes are of her creation. She has 25+ years of cooking experience.
