I, Mowarin Hensawang, a member of Heyday 68 LLC., submit this statement to supplement its application to Community Board 4 wherein it seeks a "no objection" to an on-premise liquor license.

Heyday 68 LLC d/b/a Lum Lum is a restaurant that will specialize in Thai cuisine. It located on 49 Street between Ninth and Tenth Avenues. The premises was previously occupied by Pam Real Thai food which was forced to close after twenty years because of economic hardships that stemmed from the COVID-19 pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic has challenged a once thriving restaurant industry. The traditional brick and mortar restaurant is not the only competition as the world wide web has provided alternative opportunities to dine at home during the pandemic. As a full service restaurant, I hope to provide my customers with an enjoyable experience that can only be experienced in a brick and mortar restaurant. I seek a liquor license because I would like to provide my customers the option to order beer, wine, cider or liquor Our competition is not limited to Thai restaurants. Our competition is with their meal. any restaurant in the vicinity that provides the consumer a choice. There are non-Thai restaurants within the vicinity that serve liquor. Certainly, the choice to dine at an establishment that serves liquor will eliminate the choice to dine at an establishment that only serves beer and wine or is not licensed to sell alcohol at all. The New York City restaurant industry is competitive and it is my business judgment that a liquor license will help me compete effectively with other restaurants. The grant of an on-premise liquor license to a Thai restaurant within Community Board 4 (CB 4) is not unprecedented Attached as **Exhibit A** is a 500 foot map (LAMP Proximity Report) of premises licensed by the New York State Liquor Authority. Of the eighteen active on premises liquor licenses within 500 feet of the premises, there is only one Thai restaurant (VIV) located at 717 9th Avenue with a full liquor license within 500 feet of the premises.

Issuance of a liquor license will not be contrary to the public interest. My restaurant will operate as a good neighbor. The restaurant will be open daily from 12pm to 10pm and will be personally managed by a member of the applicant. The business will focus on dining with beverages as complement to the meal. There will not be loud amplified music, open windows, large screen televisions, dancing, private parties, live music or customers gathering in large crowds outside the premises. I met with HK49-54 Block Alliance on December 22, 2021 to discuss my application. I am unaware of any objections.

The premises was previously occupied by a Thai restaurant for twenty years. I am unaware of any history of complaints against prior businesses at this location. There is

no impact on traffic in the area. The restaurant is close to public transportation. I expect most patrons will reside locally and walk.

For these reasons, I respectfully seek the Community Board's "no objection" to my application for a liquor license.
