

Also, since we will continue to have low volume pre-recorded music and a casual atmosphere, we do not anticipate any sound from within the restaurant being heard outside of the restaurant. Further, Community Board 6 unanimously approved our proposed use, the method of operation and the hours of operation of the proposed restaurant as a restaurant wine licensed venture and again for a full on-premises liquor license (THIS LAST SENTENCE WILL OBVIOUSLY HAVE TO WAIT].

Accordingly, and for all the reasons stated above, we believe that the grant of a full onpremises liquor license to the applicant would be in the public interest and a great convenience and advantage to our community.
