- The bar/tavern will be adequately supervised during all hours of operation by the applicant and employees as needed.
- The employees will be trained on proper alcoholic beverage service, to ask for ID before making a sale and to not sell to intoxicated patrons.
- Security Cameras and monitored Security System will also be installed at the premises for purposes of supervision: total of 26 security cameras.
- Business Owner will train employees to properly handle unruly patrons by asking them to leave the establishment and/or involving the police department if and where necessary.
- All patrons will be screened at the front entrance by a staff member, who will confirm the patron's advance registration through applicant's website.
- The applicant will also have double security doors (with magnetic locks), and a video intercom system at the door.

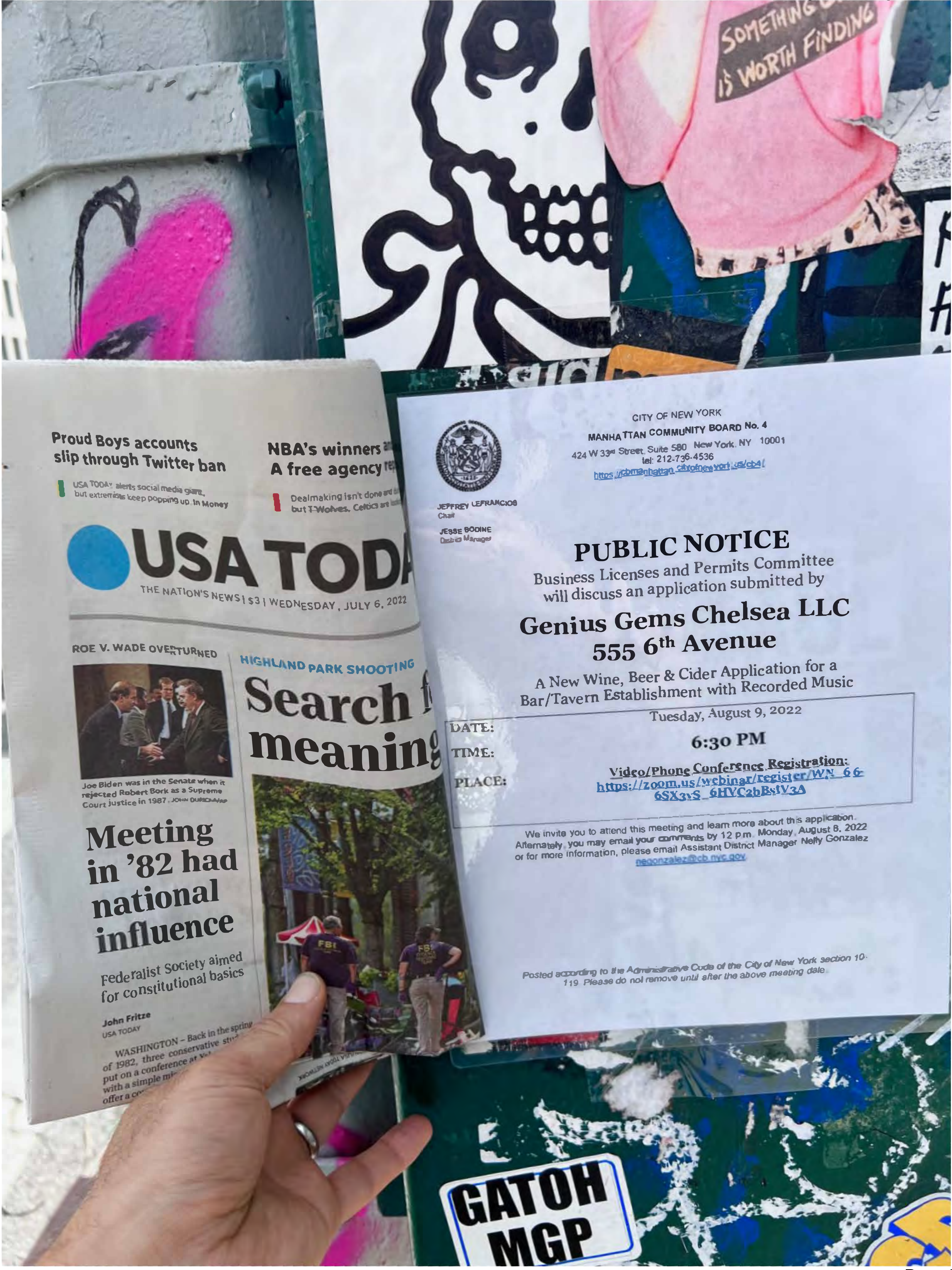

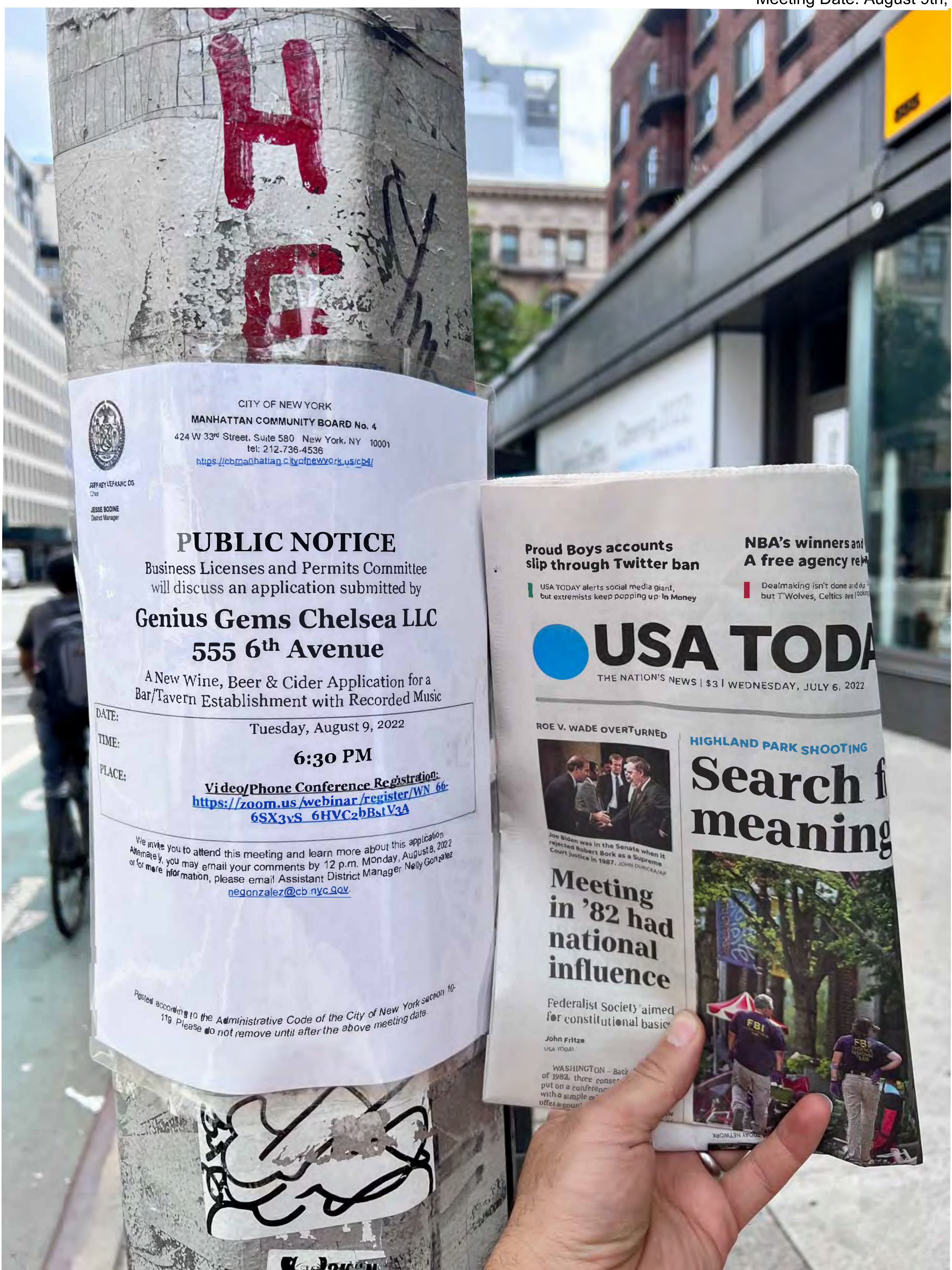

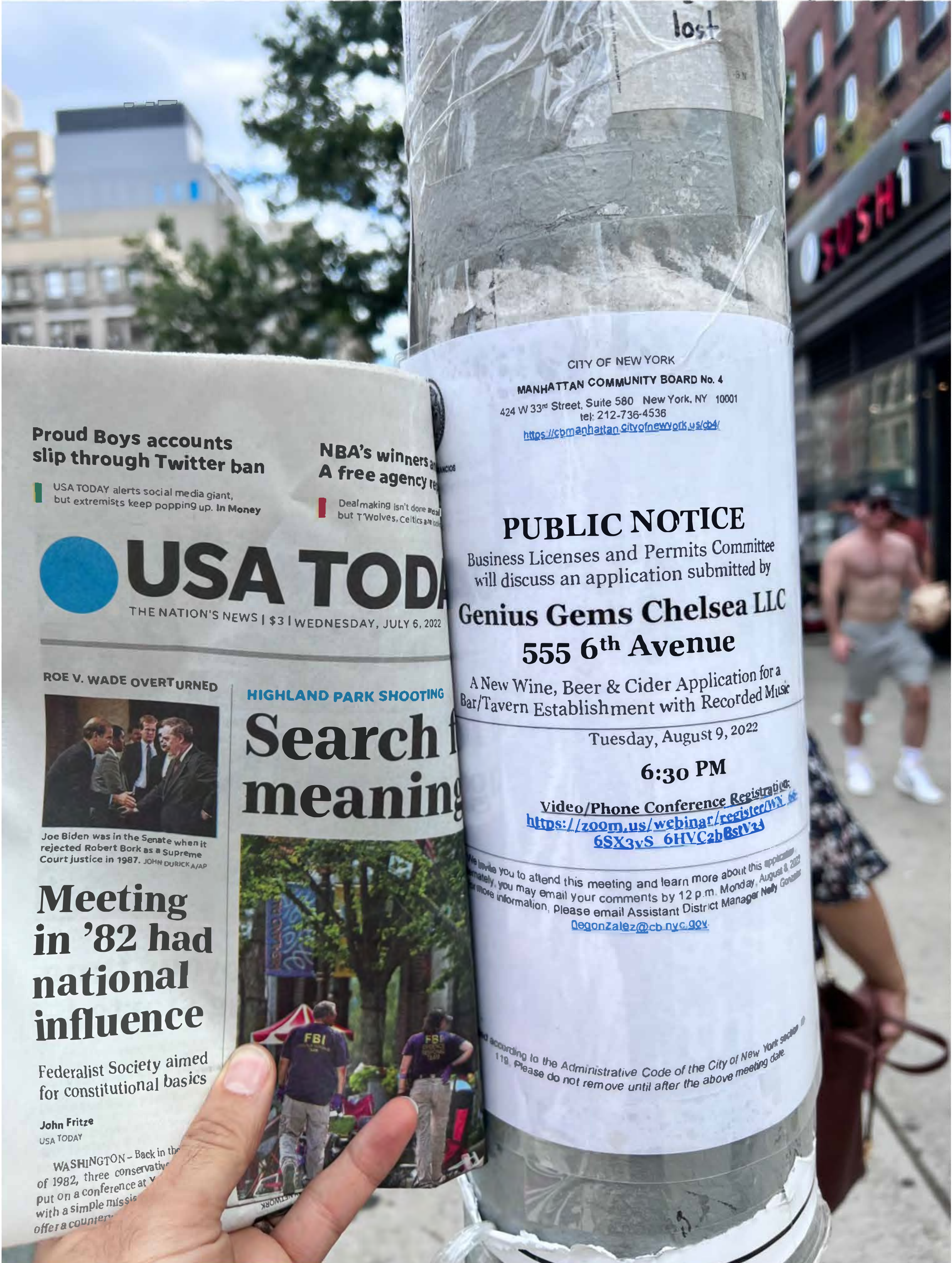
