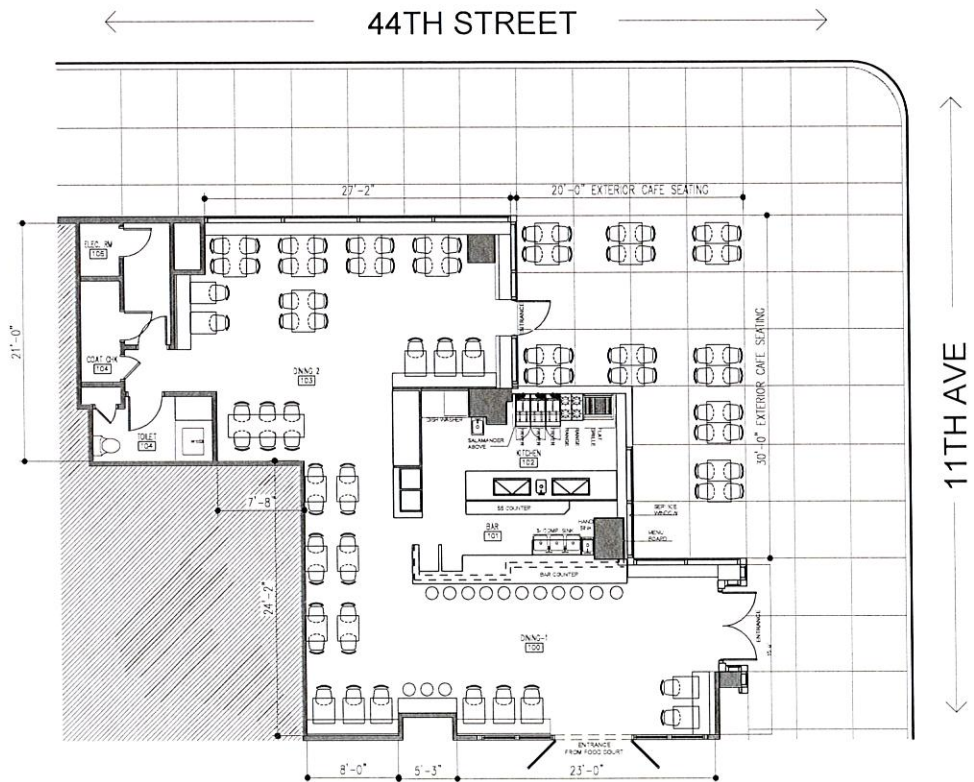

Among tax lawyers, the most raucous type of random audit carded out by the I.R.S. is known, in part partly jokingly, as "an autopsy without the benefit of death." The odds of being selected for an audit in any given year are about 1 in 100. But in 2017, for example, the I.R.S. targeted about 8,000 returns for the same type of audit Mr. Comey had undergone from the 154 million individual returns filed in 2010, or about one in 19,250.
