Please be advised that this firm represents LOOK Cinemas V, LLC with respect to their liquor license application for a proposed movie theater located at 657 West 57th Street. The applicants will be opening a movie theater with a bar and sidewalk cafe in this location later this year (please note that the sidewalk café will not open until spring 2023). The proposed premises, formerly occupied by Landmark Theaters, will have 8 theaters, theater concessions, and bar with dining area. There are 13 seats at the bar, and 9 tables with 31 seats in the bar dining area. There will also be a sidewalk café with 7 tables and 22 seats at tables. The theater will occasionally host private/corporate/promotional events in the theater auditoriums (similar to what other theaters do). The premises will be open to the public Monday – Sunday from 9 am - 2 am. The sidewalk café will be open Sunday – Thursday from 9 am – 10 pm and Friday and Saturday from 9 am – 11 pm. Recorded background music will be played softly throughout the interior of the premises. The theater only occupies space on the ground floor of the building. The trade name of the theater has not yet been determined.

Community Board 4's Business Licenses & Permits Committee will take this application up at a meeting scheduled for Tuesday, September 13, 2022 at 6:30 pm via ZOOM.

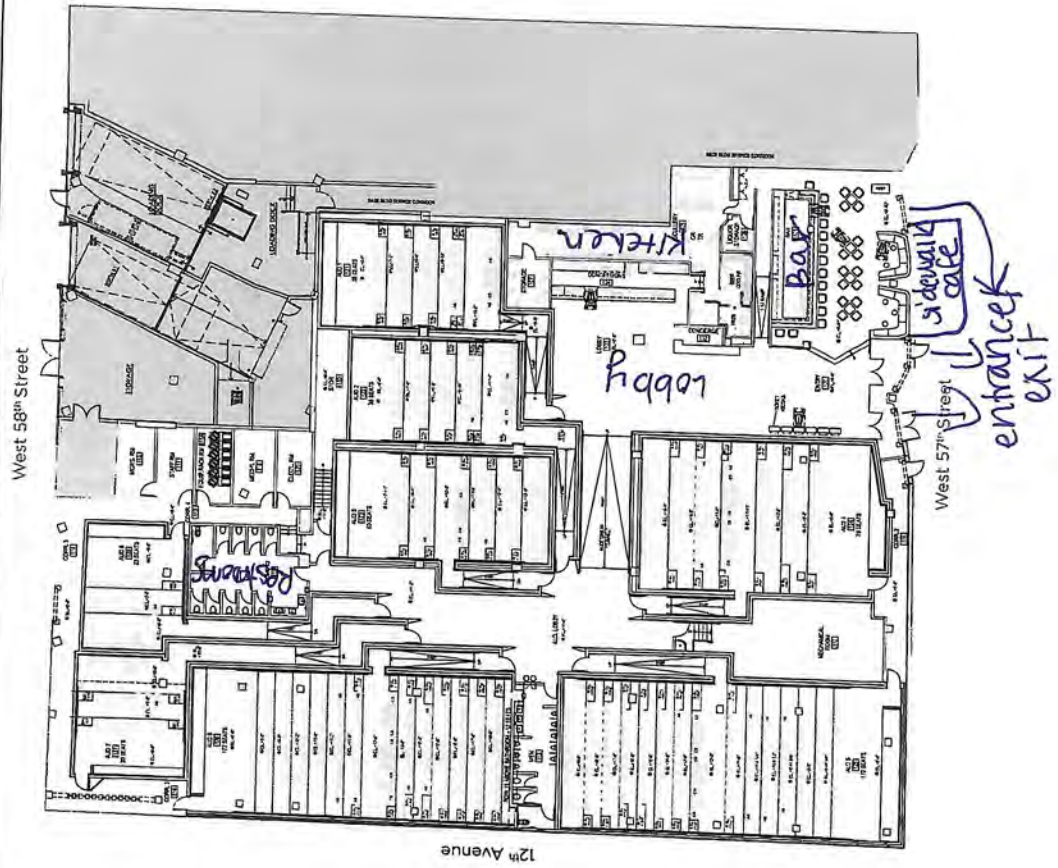
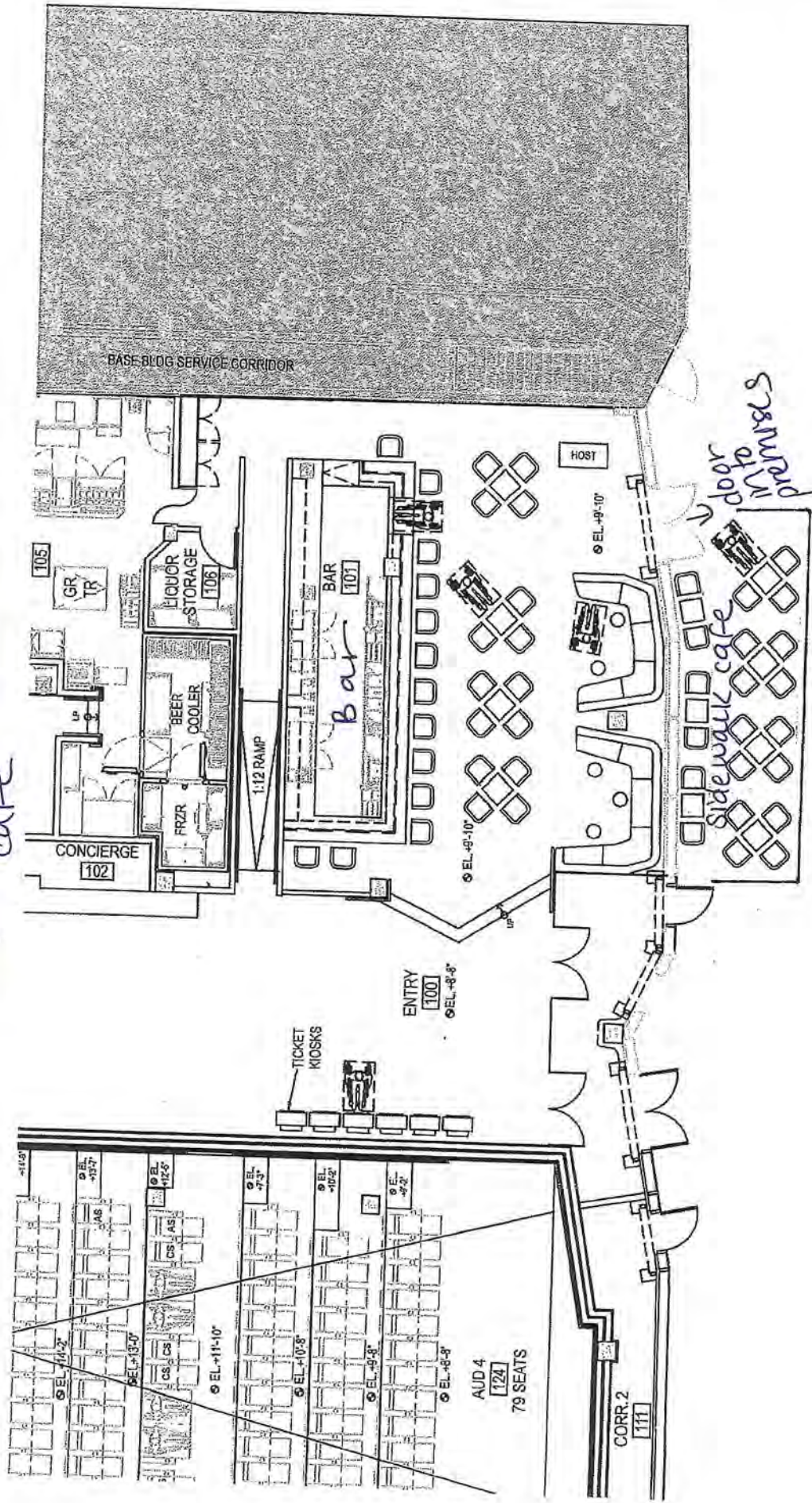
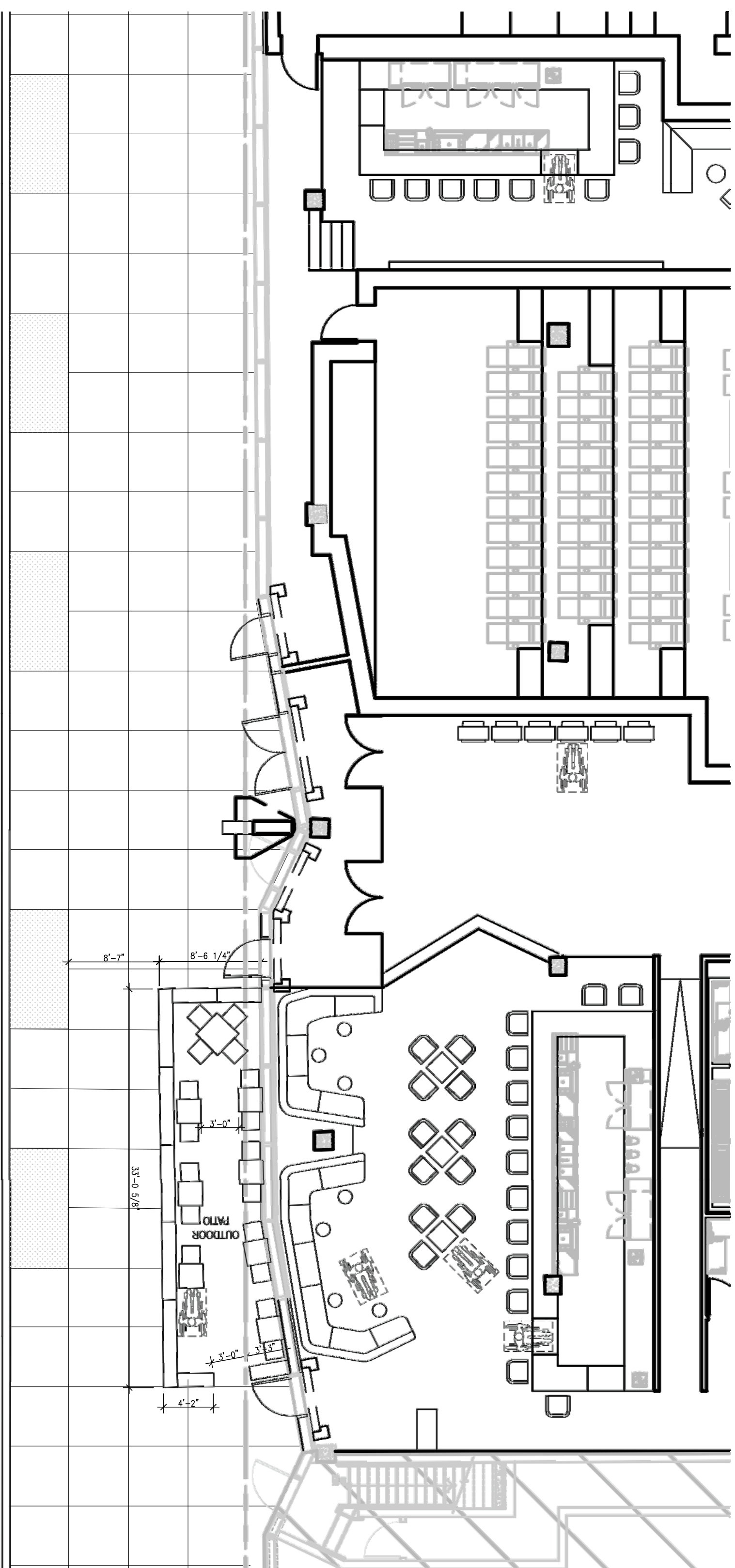


Diagram of sidewalk cafe
