Re: Sidewalk Extensions on Ninth Avenue (West 34th – West 51st)

Dear Borough Commissioner Pincar,

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) at its February 1st Full Board meeting, by a vote of 41 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstaining, and 0 present but not eligible, requests that the New York City Department of Transportation (DOT) complete its installation of wider sidewalks on the East side of Ninth Avenue from West 34th to West 51st Streets.

The widening between West 57th and West 51st Street was just completed and has been extremely popular with pedestrians. The widening between West 30th and West 34th Streets is underway.

In the last 20 years, pedestrian traffic has significantly increased due to the explosion of trains and bus commuters and the development of Hudson Yards. The section between West 34th and West 51st Street experiences even more pedestrian traffic due to the proximity to West 42nd Street, the Port Authority Bus Terminal, Moynihan Station, Midtown West, and Hudson Yards. At the same time numerous restaurants have sidewalk cafes that take a significant portion of the sidewalk capacity.

According to DOT's Pedestrian Mobility Plan¹, as is appropriate for a regional corridor, Ninth Avenue sidewalks should be 20-ft wide. However, the sidewalks have been shrunk to a total of 12-ft including the trap doors. This is woefully inadequate.
